HSC BOARD ELECTIONS

Updcoming HSC Board of Directors Elections. In accordance with the HSC Bylaws, an election for 2 board positions will be held in October 2024. To be eligible for a Board seat, prospective nominees will need to fill out an application that includes a commitment of intent to uphold the HSC mission, bylaws and policies. Incumbent board embers are eligible to apply as well.

Board members once elected will need to become USA Swimming members, pass a background check, and take Athlete Protection Training which can take up to 30 days. Board members must keep their eligibility current throughout their term. Terms are for 2 years. A formal statement with additional details and an application have been make available on the HSC website.

Nominating Committee Members Sought

The HSC Board is looking for a group of 3-4 parent volunteers to be the nominating committee for the upcoming HSC Board Elections. The task of the nominating committee is to read through nomination applications for eligibility, to recommend the final list of elgible applicants, notify ineligible applicants, to develop the final ballot, count votes, and release results for publication to HSC membership. At least one incumbant board member will assist with this process.
