2023 Dues

Maintaining a high quality swim team that is accessible and affordable continues to be a priority for Humboldt Swim Club. The HSC Board of Directors has finalized the 2023 budget, and there will be no increase in dues for 2023. HSC is a non-profit and we are reliant on balancing membership dues, corporate sponsorships, and family fundraising to cover all of the annual operating expenses for the team, such as coaching staff, pool rentals, coach travel for swim meets, and other administrative costs required to keep the club running.

2022 and 2023 Fundraising Obligation

There will be no increase in the fundraising obligation for each family for 2023. The fundraising obligation per family will continue to be \$400 per family. Families who have not raised \$400 in fundraising for 2022 will be charged the balance in January 2023. Members who joined late in the year have been prorated and all Creepy Crawl & Sponsorship Drive fundraising amounts have been added to accounts.

The two largest fundraisers for 2023 will be the Sponsorship Drive and the Creepy Crawl Lap-a-Thon. The sponsorship drive will take place January through May. For every family that secures a team sponsor, 50% of sponsorship funds raised goes toward your family fundraising requirement for the year. The Creepy Crawl Lap-a-Thon will take place in October. 100% of donations brought in for the Creepy Crawl will count towards the family annual obligation. We are always looking for parent volunteers to coordinate additional fundraisers. Please reach out to any board member if you'd like to lead any additional fundraisers for 2023.

Thank you to everyone who took time out of your busy schedules to respond to the Humboldt Swim Club 2021-2022 Season Stakeholder Survey. The primary take-aways from this year's survey is that parents and swimmers would still like to see improved communications coming from the board and from coaches. Our members would like to know more in advance about what is coming up for each specific meet. They would also like to know more about volunteering opportunities. Parents and swimmers asked about bringing back intrasquad meets and about more substantive ways in which to help make swimming more affordable for families, especially as swimmers move up into the Senior levels.

Last year the board offered scholarships throughout the year to eligible families to help offset membership fees. That scholarship will expire at the end of this month, but we do hope to apply again for the coming year. We will report out on the 2021-2022 scholarship next month.

Pacific Swimming does have some assistance available to help offset costs through its Meet Entry Fee Assistance Program (MEFAP): Pacific Swimming has introduced a new Meet Entry Fee Assistance Program (MEFAP) to help swimmers cover the costs of entering swim meets. The swimmer would pay for the splash fee associated with each meet and Pacific Swimming will cover the individual swims' entry fees. To be eligible, swimmers must be an Outreach registered athlete OR have a family-proven hardship, verified by a coach. Swimmers may register for each meet through their coach/club.
