This stage of training focuses on water comfort, basic technique, and learning what it means to be part of a team. I can proudly say that this group has embraced all of it with great energy! BRONZE GROUP

Happy December, Bronze Group! The swimmers are improving fast when it comes to their body alignment and developing better efficiency across all four strokes. Freestyle rotation and their breathing are becoming more natural, and many athletes are maintaining a longer, cleaner stroke. Backstroke technique is improving as swimmers focus on controlled kick tempo, keeping their head still, and finishing into the wall on their back. Breaststroke timing has been a major area of progress, especially with swimmers learning to keep their kick narrow and glide between each pull. Butterfly is becoming smoother as athletes focus on maintaining rhythm, keeping their hips up, and using a strong kickoff from the core.

Bronze Swimmer of the Month: Max Beltran- Max had outstanding performances at the Fort Bragg meet smashing his best times left and right. Congrats Max!

SILVER GROUP

Happy December, Silver Group! Silver swimmers are building consistency across all four strokes, with a major emphasis on efficiency, body line, and stroke count. Freestyle technique is improving through better rotation, stronger kick, and controlled breathing patterns. Backstroke tempo and underwaters have shown strong gains, especially among swimmers committing to a powerful kick through the whole 25. Breaststroke timing is becoming more refined with several swimmers now maintaining a clear pull-kick-glide rhythm. Butterfly endurance and rhythm have improved as well, with more athletes sustaining legal and efficient fly for longer distances.

Silver Swimmer of the Month: Banyan Villagomez - Banyan had some great swims at the Fort Bragg meet. Way to go Banyan!

WHAT DO THE DIFFERENT TYPES OF MEETS MEAN FOR MY **SWIMMER?**

Swim meets are based on USA and Pacific Swimming Time Standards. These standards are grouped into Age Group and Senior Times. These time standards can be found at https://www.pacswim.org/swim-meet-times/standards

- C/B/A+ Meets = All swimmers may attend. Zone 3 Championships = swimmers must qualify with either A or B times

- Age Group Meets:

 Age Group Championships = swimmers must meet the age group time standard

 Far Western Championships = swimmers must meet
- the FW time standard

- Senior Meets:

 Senior Open = swimmers 13 and up with Senior Open
- times qualify Senior 2 = swimmers 13 and up must have Senior 2 times qualify
- Western Zones Senior Championship = swimmers 13 and up must meet Senior Western Zone times.
- Sectionals = swimmers must meet the minimum sectional time standards

Stroke and Turn Official

Thank you Beth Spellmeyer for attending the annual PAC Swim Officials Clinic as a representative of HSC!

"Hey everyone! I had a fantastic time at the official's clinic in Pleasant Hill on October 4th. It was a great chance to connect with other officials in Pacific Swimming. I learned a lot about the role of chief judge (aka chief inspector of turns) and becoming a starter. The chief judge is "middle management" as it was coined and tends to do a lot of the gopher duties. They make the rotation for the other stroke and turn officials (which still makes my brain spin), pick up DQ slips and will distribute to coaches. It is the job of hurry up and wait but when you're on-your on. The starter is the voice of the meet and makes sure there is a fair start for all! I will now start to apprentice in these roles and after 4 sessions I will become officially certified in these roles.
