2024 Dues & Fundraising Obligation

Maintaining a high quality swim team that is accessible and affordable continues to be a priority for Humboldt Swim Club. The HSC Board of Directors has finalized the 2024 budget, and there will be no dues increase for 2024. Our operating costs continue to rise, and we anticipate needing to raise dues in 2025. HSC is a non-profit and we are reliant on balancing membership dues, corporate sponsorships and family fundraising to cover all of the annual operating costs for the team. We thank our families and strive to continue to keep swimming affordable and accessible to everyone.

The Fundraising obligation per family will continue to be \$400 per year. Families who have not raised \$400 in 2023 will be billed the balance in January 2024. The two largest fundraisers for 2024 will be the Sponsorship Drive and Creepy Crawl Lap-a-Thon. The Sponsorship Drive will take place January-May; for every family that secures a team sponsor 50% of the funds raised goes toward your family fundraising requirements for the year. The Creepy Crawl Lap-a-Thon will take place in October; 100% of the donations brought in for Creepy Crawl will count toward a families fundraising obligation.

WHAT DO THE DIFFERENT TYPES OF MEETS MEAN FOR MY **SWIMMER?**

Swim meets are based on USA and Pacific Swimming Time Standards. These standards are grouped into Age Group and Senior Times. These time standards can be found at https://www.pacswim.org/swim-meet-times/standards

C/B/A+ Meets = All swimmers may attend. Zone 3 Championships = swimmers must qualify with either A or B times

Age Group Meets:

• Age Group Championships = swimmers must meet the JŎ time standard

Far Western Championships = swimmers must meet the FW time standard

Senior Meets:
Senior Open = swimmers 13 and up with Senior Open times qualify
Senior 2 = swimmers 13 and up must have Senior 2

times qualify

Western Zones Senior Championship = swimmers 13 and up must meet Senior Western Zone times.

Sectionals = swimmers must meet the minimum sectional time standards

GROUP CRITERIA + GROUP COACHES

Coach Jacob & Coach Kelly are working on new group criteria for 2024.

The updated criteria will be available in next month's newsletter as well as on Team Unify.

The group criteria will be a bullet list of elements which swimmers must be proficient in to move into the next group. This list will allow for transparency in move up decisions, all while maintaining coach discretion.

Age Group Criteria Coming Soon!

Intro Group: Coach Madeline is our Inro Coach!

Bronze Group: Coach Mary is our Bronze Coach!
Silver Group: Lead Age-Group Coach Kelly is our Silver Coach! Gold Group: Lead Age-Group Coach Kelly is our Gold Coach!

Senior Group: Lead Senior Group Coach Jacob is our Senior Coach!

Senior Comp: Lead Senior Group Coach Jacob is our Senior Comp

Standards for the Senior Comp Group:

- Age 13 and older
- Compete in all scheduled monthly competitions and their designated championship meet for the competition cycle
- Maintain an 80% monthly attendance record
- PacSwim Senior 2 cut in at least one event
- Train at a base 100 pace of 1:20 and a base 50 pace of :40
- Race pace train at 1:15/100 and :35/50
- Members of the Senior program must have their own equipment: snorkel, paddles, fins, buoy, and alignment board.

The HSC Board is pleased to announce that we received a competitive grant \$3,600 grant from

Pacific Swimming's, Disability, Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Committee that will be used to offset the costs of renting the Cal Poly Humboldt swimming pool for use for intrasquad meets.

This is something the team might otherwise not be able to afford without passing on these costs to you. The Cal Poly pool is the only facility in our area with 6 lanes and a full set of diving blocks. The use of this facility for intrasquad swim meets will provide our swimmers a chance to compete without the costs of travel and transportation. We will share the dates of these events soon!
