Humboldt Swim Club participates in Safesport https://uscenterforsafesport.org as required by USA Swimming All of our coaches, board members and swimmers 18 or older are required to take annual training. We are also trying to be certified as a Safesport team. If just a few more parents or swimmers 13-17 would take the voluntary training, we will meet our mark. Here's how. Log into your USAswimming account, click on the Education heading, look in the course catalog then for "Safe Sport Courses". The three most common courses are: Parents Guide to Misconduct in Sport, Safesport for High School Athletes, and Safesport for Youth Athletes (13-17).

Pacific Swimming has assistance available to help offset costs through its Meet Entry Fee Assistance Program (MEFAP): To be eligible, swimmers must be an Outreach registered athlete OR have a family-proven hardship, verified by a coach.
