

Team Registration

It's time for our annual team registration for the 2022 season. All continuing members must register annually with USA Swimming and Humboldt Swim Club (HSC). The 2022 USA Swimming registration fee per swimmer is \$84.00, and the 2022 HSC administration fee per family is \$50. All HSC members registering for the 2022 season will receive an HSC team shirt and team cap. Payment is due at the time of registration.

Registration is completed entirely online and our online registration packet includes all forms that are required to be signed by all USA Swimming members annually.

Registration is open now and will be open through September 18th. All swimmers must complete the online registration by September 18, 2021 to continue practicing with HSC and/or attend any meets.

Going through the annual registration process is a great time to check and update your general contact information, t-shirt size information and emergency contact info. Each account can have multiple email addresses listed and all emails on the account will receive our team emails, so multiple household members, and multiple households can stay informed with team communications. Older swimmers who have their own email addresses can also be added.

When you register, you will need to select your designated practice group. Please select the group that your swimmer has been assigned by the coaching staff. Attached is a copy of the current roster by group. Coaching staff will be reviewing and approving the groups selected during the registration process and you will be notified if you registered for the wrong group.
