Happy July, happy summer everyone! I've been on vacation and so the report is brief this month. Notably, FINA the governing body of international swimming, including the Olympics, has recently issued a ruling on transgender athletes participation in competition. For a copy of this new and controversial policy, please see FINA Policy

New: USA Swim Registration Process

USA Swimming will be changing their annual registration process to an online platform later this year. This is a big change since HSC has processed all of the USA swimming registrations for new and continuing members in the past. Clubs have limited information on how exactly the process will work at this time and we'll do our best to provide all the information we have as timely as possible. What we do know is that the members will be sent a web link later this year, and they will need to create a Ping account to link their membership and pay their annual registration fee for the 2023 year online. This will likely occur in October or November of this year. It may be a bit bumpy, but we'll do our best to provide support to families if they're having any issues.

New and existing members will also receive a new unique 14 character alphanumeric member code to replace their existing USA Swimming ID. And, Deck Pass will no longer be available beginning September 1, so we encourage each member to save a pdf copy of their DeckPass information with their current USA swimming ID so you have it readily available to reference during this switch to the new process. You can get to DeskPass by logging into your account on our team website and clicking USAS Deck Pass. You can also get to it through the USA Swimming Deck Pass app.

Scholarships Available

HSC strives to offer the opportunity for everyone to participate in our swim program, regardless of financial means or limitations. Toward this end, HSC offers financial aid to assist with monthly dues. **Scholarships cover at least 50% of dues**. Due to HSC recently being awarded a grant that we had applied for, HSC may be able to increase the percentage of dues to be covered with the scholarship for the remainder of the 2022 year. This will depend on the number of scholarship applicants received, as we want to support as many members who need financial support as possible.

To qualify, families just need to fill out our scholarship application on our website under Membership and show proof of Medi-Cal. Please don't delay in turning in the paperwork if you qualify!
