The BDST (Blue Dolphin Swim Team) has updated their fees for the 2025-2026 season. Tuition fees will now be offered in two categories: full-season and half-season. The full-season training period spans from September 2025 to the end of July 2026. The half-season training period runs from September 2025 to the end of January 2026, and from February 2026 to the end of July 2026.

The team registration period is open from June 2th to June 30th. For those wishing to register outside of the team, the registration period will be from July 1st to July 31st.

Pacific northwest swim Registration fee for 2026 is \$84.

(Premium members no unlimited to annual competitions)

Pacific northwest swim Registration fee for 2026 is \$30 (Level 1 and Level 2).

(Junior members can participate in 2 swimming competitions per year)

Development group

Level 1: One to two hours of training per week with (age 6 to 10 years old, no swim meets).

Level 2: One to three hours of training per week (age 6 to 10 years old, with the option to participate in short course swim meets, such as 25 or 50 yards).

Level 3: One to three hours of training per week (age 6 to 12 years old, with the option to participate in short course swim meets, such as 50, 100, or 200 yards).

Please note that players who do not participate in swim meets are unable to move up to Level 4 or above with only one to two hours of training per week.

If you would like to upgrade to Level 4 or increase your training time, you must participate in at least six swim meets per year.

Competition group

Level 4: One to three hours of training per week (age 6 to 12 years old, with a minimum of four to six competitions per year).

S-Team: One to six hours of training per week (PNS Silver or Gold standard required, age 8 to 12 years old, minimum 8 to 10 swim meet per year).

Age gourp: One to five hours of training per week (age 13 to 18 years old).

Cancel Course Instructions

In the event of inclement weather or equipment failure during a scheduled competition in the swimming pool, the swimming pool management may unilaterally request closure, resulting in the cancellation of water training. Please note that the swimming team will not provide make-up arrangements for any missed training due to these circumstances.

BDST make-up policy

To request a leave of absence, please send an email to <u>BlueDolphinAttend@hotmail.com</u>. In your email, please provide your name, level, and requested make-up time. Please note that no make-up sessions will be scheduled for players who do not take a leave of absence.

For absences due to sickness or a girls' menstrual period, make-up lessons can be arranged. However, make-up lessons will not be arranged for absences due to parties, travel, other class conflicts, or other personal reasons.

Please also note that make-up lessons need to be adjusted to a lower level or other training time, and are only applicable to the 2025-2026 season. They cannot be carried over to the following season.

Refund policy

Refund application conditions

Before the course starts: If a student needs a refund for personal reasons (e.g. health reasons, family emergencies, etc.) before the official start of the course, please submit valid supporting documents, and if you meet the conditions for a refund, you may apply for a refund after mutual negotiation, subject to the deduction of a handling fee of 50% of the total fee (to cover the administrative and management costs already incurred).

After the start of the course: If you cannot continue to participate in the training due to personal reasons, no refund will be given.

New Season Group Adjustment Notice:

As the new season approaches in September, we will be adjusting training group placements based on each student's development progress and age. The specific arrangements are as follows:

- 1. Students currently in Level 1 and Level 1.5 \rightarrow Will be uniformly promoted to Level 2.
- 2. Students currently in Level $2 \rightarrow$ Will be promoted to Level 3.
- 3. Students currently in Level $3 \rightarrow \text{Will}$ be promoted to Level 4.
- 4. Students currently in Level 4 → Will be placed according to the following criteria:
- Those who have achieved PNS qualifying standards in competitions will be promoted to the S-Team.
- Those who are 13 years old or older and do not have competition plans will be moved to the Age Group.
- Those who do not meet either of the above criteria will remain in Level 4.

5. Swimmers in S-Team and Age group will maintain current levels.

This adjustment is intended to provide each student with a more suitable training environment, supporting their continuous progress and growth in the upcoming season.

Swim Team Dismissal Policy

If an athlete is found to be disobedient to coaches, disrespectful to others, engaging in bullying, intentionally damaging public property at the pool, or participating in dangerous behavior that may cause harm to themselves or others, the swim team will issue one warning. If the behavior is not corrected after the warning, the athlete's training privileges will be immediately suspended. All tuition already paid is non-refundable.
