This past weekend we had backstrokers Claire Ryan and Tyler Bates represent Storm at Washington State Champs!Claire dropped time in all of her events! On Saturday she dropped time in her 200 back, getting 2:25.60 and earning the 6th spot on the Storm Top 10! On Sunday she dropped time in both her 50 free and 50 backstroke!

Tyler was close to his season best in the 200 back and the 100 fly. He ended up dropping time in both of his events on Sunday, earning a top 10 time in the 500 free with 5:18.02 and 27.68 in the 50 backstroke.



- Storm swimmers and parents set up and clean up time: 6:45pm set up and clean up is until 9pm (swimmers and parent/guardians can earn up to 2.25 hours EACH at this event)
- Tickets: Cash or check only. Tickets can be purchased on the 10th starting at 6:45pm for Storm swimmers and 7pm for family/friends/general public.
- Other volunteer info: Positions to hand out flyers, text a reminder to Storm families, run games, coordinate volunteers, and set up/run food tables is linked above. Swimmers can volunteer 30 min and swim for 1 hour or choose to volunteer the entire time! We will ask Storm swim volunteers to wear their caps during volunteer time.
- The flyer is now finalized with details a color copy and extra small copies (to share with friends) will be passed out to families during practices between Dec 29-Jan 2 (or until the 10th).

FAQ

Q - Do Storm swimmers have to buy a ticket? A - Yes, this year Storm swimmers have to purchase a ticket, but it's half price.

Q - Do Storm swimmers siblings/friends have to buy a ticket?
A - Yes.

Q - What kind of games do we have?
A - As of today - water "shark rugby", water "shark basketball", pin the smile on the shark, and a ping pong/bucket game - maybe more will be added! Storm swimmers can sign up for which set up tasks and then games to help with once they arrive.

Q - Do parents have to buy a ticket?
A - Only if they plan to swim. Any kids
wearing a life jacket or are 7 and under
require a parent/guardian in the water with
them.

Q - Do Storm swimmers get the full volunteer time if they choose to swim for an hour? A - Storm swimmers will get the amount of time they volunteer. For example, if a Storm swimmer volunteers starting at 6:45 (helps clean up and stays after to offer clean up help until 9pm) and can volunteer during the event for at least 30 min, they will get 1 hour. The rest of the time they can swim.
