Considering charging a service fee of \$20-25 next year if families choose invoice over donation. Almost 200 families will be invoiced. This is a lot of work for Laurae.

Planning on distribution at the awards banquet May 15<sup>th</sup>.

After discussion with Laurae, I think we need to be clearer about the distribution of the funds.

- The first 50K goes to financial aid and diversity and inclusion,
- The majority of the funds are used for other things like travel expenses etc...
- The team does a great job of using those funds equitably and if we were more transparent, we could celebrate how those funds are used for the team and gain better team understanding and desire to fundraise

Also wondering if this is the first at, we want to use moving forward. Meaning steer away from big event and do more like what was done this year. If so, I would need to change the communication about the event.

## Andrea, Meet Director Report

**May 1st (Sunday morning)** – May Mini meet at Lakeridge. Meet director – Andrea, Meet referee – Carl

- Identical to February mini meet format
- Outdoors so spectators will be allowed on the upper lawn. Will also stream meet if streaming volunteer available
- Will need to provide lifeguards so some additional volunteer opportunities for senior families

**June 24-26, 2022 –** Summer Classic LC meet at KCAC. Meet director – Laurie, Meet referee – Carl

October 15-16, 2022 – Fall Kickoff at Snohomish

**March 4-5, 2023** – Snohomish reserved for last chance meet
