FACILITY INFORMATION:

- 25 yard, 6-lane competitive pool
- Starting end 9.5 feet deep; turning end 5.5 feet deep
- The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).
- Spectator seating: Facility's COVID-19 restrictions apply; information about alternate viewing arrangements will be provided to all participating teams.
- Colorado timing system; scoreboard w/one-lane readout
- Heat Sheets will be posted; Results on PNS website
- · Parking: multiple school parking lots

ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY INFORMATION:

- This meet is an invitational. Teams interested in an invitation should contact the Meet Director. An invitation does not guarantee acceptance due to timeline and facility limitations.
- All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming through an associated NCSSL member club.
- Neither on-deck USA Swimming registration nor any on-deck club transfer will be permitted.
- Age groups are based on the swimmer's age as of the first day of the meet.
- Each swimmer may enter no more than three (3) individual events and two (2) relay events. Entries exceeding these limits will be scratched without notification, and entry fees for entry count limitation scratches will not be refunded.
- De-qualifying times for 9&O swimmers only:
 - Any swimmer who has achieved a current PNS "Gold" time in either a USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition or in a NCSSL meet is not eligible to compete in that event and may not swim a relay leg in that stroke/distance.
 - Any swimmer with a 2021 PNS 14U Champs qualifying time is not eligible to compete in this meet.
 - There are no dequalifying times for 8&U swimmers
- · No deck entries
- All USA Swimming registration numbers will be verified with the PNS registration database.

ENTRY FEES:

Surcharge: \$ 10.00Individual Event: \$ 4.50Relay Event: \$ 12.00

- No refunds or credits will be given for events entered but not swum
- · All fees must accompany entries.

AWARDS AND SCORING:

- Individual events: Medals 1st 3rd places, Ribbons 4th 6th places for individual events in each awards age group
- Relay events: Ribbons 1st 3rd places for relay events in each awards age group

MEET RULES:

- MMSC-PN's and the facility's Covid-19 guidelines and procedures apply to this meet.
- Current PNS and USA Swimming rules govern throughout the meet, including warm-ups.
- Events will be seeded SCY/SCM/LCM.
- All 8&U 25-yard events will start in the water at the bulkhead end of the pool.
- Relays: Each relay team may be either single-gender or mixed, but mixed relays may only be composed of two girls and two boys.
 The lead-off swimmer's time of any relay not composted of two eligible girls and two eligible boys will not go into USA Swimming's database and will not be considered an official time.
 - The second and fourth swimmer of each 100-yard relay must start in the water.
 - Should timeline constraints so require, some or all relay events will be dropped and the entry fees will be refunded.

WARM-UP PROCEDURES:

- · Circle swim counter-clockwise only.
- · Last 10 minutes of each warm-up period:
 - Lanes 1 & 6 pace lanes, no diving
 - · Lanes 2 & 5 sprint lanes, dive starts
 - · Lanes 3 & 4 general warm-up, no diving
 - Additional sprint lanes may be made available upon request to the Meet Referee.
- Pool closed promptly five (5) minutes prior to the start of competition.
- Warm-up may be modified at the discretion of the Meet Referee to accommodate the number of swimmers entered.

SAFETY INFORMATION:

- All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP") and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a precondition of participation in the conduct of this meet. In addition, all 18&O athletes must be current in their Athlete Protection Training (APT) in order to swim.
- The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell
 phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, or locker
 rooms. Recording devices (cell phones, cameras, PDAs, etc.) are
 not permitted behind the starting blocks during the entire meet. In
 the event of any disputes regarding video recording, the Referee's
 decision shall be final and binding.
- · Deck changes are prohibited.

- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
- The bulkhead is closed at all times.
- No diving from the blocks or sides of pool except for designated sprint lanes during designated times in main pool.
- · Jumping into the pool is not allowed.
- Backstroke swimmers enter the water feet first in rotation; no diving over persons in the water.
- Deck Marshals will be assigned to supervise the warm-up. Deck Marshals have the authority to remove any swimmer, coach, or club who does not follow the safety rules during warm-ups or the meet
- Coaches are responsible for their team's swimmers throughout the meet, including warm-ups and warm-downs.
- All participating swimmers must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach and may not enter the water at any time unless under the supervision of said coach. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist a swimmer in making supervision arrangements, but it is the swimmer's responsibility to make arrangements prior to the start of warm-ups and to so notify the Meet Referee.
- Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or of the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
- Only authorized volunteers and working personnel can be on deck.
 All others must remain in the designated spectator area and are not allowed in the designated racing venue unless timing for an event or volunteering with the management of the meet.
- In order to be on deck and serve in their official capacity, all
 officials shall visibly display their membership credentials, including
 current certification(s), at all times.
- All persons acting in any coaching capacity must be coach members of USA Swimming and must show proof of current coaching credentials when checking in for the meet.
- Alcoholic beverages, tobacco products of any kind, and glass containers are not allowed in the swimming venue.
- Any act of theft, vandalism or similar action will result in immediate disqualification from the meet and the loss of any points accumulated toward team standings by the individual.
- Team Areas: Please keep your area clean, and pick up all trash before leaving each session.
- It is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event
- It is further understood that Pacific Northwest Swimming, the North Cascade Summer Swim League, and the Mighty Marlins Swim Club shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.

The fines are due prior to the entry deadline of the next meet entered by the team being fined or within 15 business days after the receipt of the fine statement, whichever occurs first.
