## 2021 SMAC Summer Classic Meet procedures

- Masks are required for all individuals at all times (except while swimming) regardless of vaccination status. This is mandated by Snohomish Aquatic Center and is included in our meet sanction so is not negotiable.
- 2. Swimmers should use a plastic bag to store their mask while swimming during warm ups and competition. A bag will be provided if needed.
- 3. Per our meet sanction "only coaches, officials and meet volunteers" will be allowed on the pool deck. Please check in at the volunteer table on arrival.
- 4. There will be no temperature checks or COVID screening, but please use good judgement and stay home if you have a fever or are feeling sick.
- 5. **No spectators** will be allowed in the pool area, but parents will be able to remain outdoors on the premises. The meet will be livestreamed on the Snohomish Aquatic Center website.
- 6. Use of the 10 lane main pool will be limited to no more than 200 swimmers for warm ups and teams will be assigned lanes for use in warm ups. Lanes 8-10 may be used for warm up during competition with no limits but swimmers should not congregate on the wall unmasked.
- 7. Movement around the pool will be counterclockwise during competition. Designated seating areas for athletes will be located in the bleachers. Swimmers are encouraged to spread out while seated and must wear their mask while seated in the beachers.
- 8. Swimmers may choose to sit outside unmasked so bring chairs and canopies if desired. Swimmers will be responsible for keeping track of the timeline to know when to return to the pool area for their next event.
- 9. The locker rooms and showers will be open with no restrictions. Swimmers are reminded to wear their masks in the locker rooms.

In applying for this sanctioned event, the Host, Seattle Metropolitan Aquatic Club, agrees to comply and to enforce all health and safety mandates and guidelines of USA Swimming, PNS Snohomish Aquatic Center and King and Snohomish County, Washington.
