Evaluate what they can do to determine group placement and competitive/fitness goals and fit them into your program**



Connect the coach, athlete, and parents to U.S. Paralympic Swimming for para specific information and to the LSC Disability Chair for local support at meets, etc.



Determine if, in addition to their team meet schedule, the swimmer is also interested in competing in para only meets

- 1. If yes, coach, athlete, and parents attend the following free clinics:**
 - Introduction and Orientation to Para Swimming
 - Coaching a Para Swimmer to gain a deeper understanding of para-swimming.
- 2. If no, continue work within the current team meet schedules & program progress**



To compete in a para-only meet:

- 1. Review policies/paperwork for national classification.**
- 2. Complete the paperwork and submit as directed on the website:
