JOB DESCRIPTIONS

Auditor (Poolside)

The Auditor records the time, disqualifications and placement of each swimmer in the heat. The Auditor verifies that the placement designated by the Place Judges match with the times on the timing tape.

Awards (Poolside)

Volunteers will present the athletes with their awards.

Awards Staging (Poolside)

Volunteers will arrange the athletes in their award position before they go to Awards.

External Security

Outside security personnel patrol the exterior of the Aquatic Center and assist with parking. Prepare lunch distribution.

Hospitality

Volunteers in the Hospitality Room make sure that there are beverages, breakfast, lunch and snacks are available for volunteers, coaches, and families. Morning shift start time is 7:00 AM.

Marshal (Poolside)

The Marshals are responsible for escorting athletes from the time they report to the Staging Area for their event until they receive their award. Marshals work in teams of two and does a lot of walking.

Olympic Town/Arts & Crafts

Volunteers will assist athletes in participating in a variety of games and creating arts & crafts projects they can take home with them.

Place Judge (Poolside)

The duty of the Place Judge is to judge each heat by finishing order, or place. At the completion of each heat, each Place Judge determines the placement of each swimmer and then compares his/her place order with the other judges to determine the official placement for the heat.

Pool Deck Security (Poolside)

Pool deck security monitor the doors to ensure only athletes and authorized personnel have access to the pool deck.

Runner (Poolside)

The runners are responsible for collecting the necessary paperwork before and after a heat and delivering it to the appropriate area. Requires a lot of walking and you work by yourself.

Timer (Poolside)

Timers time each heat using stopwatches or the pool's electronic timekeeping system. Two or three timers are assigned to a lane. They confirm the name and lane of the swimmer and encourage the swimmer during the race

Volunteer Checkin and Information Table

Volunteer check-in is responsible for checking in all volunteers upon their arrival. The Information Table is responsible for answering questions and directing calls to the event management. The morning shift start time is 7:00 AM.
