RULES	 Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet. 			
RULES	All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted. In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods. Deck changes are prohibited. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of a backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.			
	 Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Dive-over starts will NOT be used. The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F. 			
EVENT RULES	All events are timed finals.			
	• Athletes may enter no more than five (5) events.			
	• This meet is primarily a Pentathlon. In order to enter the "Pentathlon Competition" a SWIMMER MUST SWIM ALL FOUR (4) 25/50 YARD EVENTS PLUS THE 100 YARD I.M. EVENT IN THEIR AGE GROUP. The Championship scoring will be based on the accumulated times of the five (5) events. Winner of the Pentathlon will be determined by the lowest aggregate time of the events swum. A disqualification in any one of the events will make you ineligible for the pentathlon award.			
POSITIVE CHECK IN	Deck entries will be accepted to fill empty lanes only. No new heats will be created.			
WARM-UP	 All events will be pre-seeded. The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director 			
WARNING UP	 The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director will assign warm-ups, including times/lane assignments. 			
SUPERVISION	 Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and cleaning up for their team areas. 			
MEDICAL ASSISTANCE	 This facility provides Lifeguard and Pool Operator Supervision, along with an AED. 			
SEEDING	 All events are pre-seeded. 			
SCORING	 This meet is not scored. 			
AWARDS	 Special awards will be given for 1st to 8th place – Pentathlon 			
PROGRAMS	Ribbons will be given for 1st to 8th place – Individual events. Will be emailed to attending teams/sites. No programs will be sold at the meet. Programs will be made available for coaches and officials at the meet, and available on Meet Mobile.			
CREDENTIALS	Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them at all times.

ENTRY PROCEDURES	Entries should be submitted by email to the Meet Director.			
	• Include in the subject of the email, "2024 NCAP Polar Pentathlon - ****" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. If your club submits multiple entry files include training site in the subject of the email.			
	• Include in entry email: entry file, report of entries by name, report of entries by event.			
	• In the body of your email provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (email, phone, officials contact).			
	Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted.			
	Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted.			
	• The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director.			
	• Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 by PVS and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.
