FACILITY	The St. James: Sports, Wellness, and Entertainment Complex 6508 Industrial Road Springfield, VA 22151 (703) 768-3223 The pool at The St. James is 50m x 25yd with a moveable bulkhead. Competition will be held in 8 lanes, 50 meters, running from bulkhead to wall, starting at
	the northern end of the pool. A lane will be used for continuous warm up with a gap lane separating the competition course.
	 Water depth of 6'8" at the starting end and 4' at the turning end.
	The meet hosts will ensure the required course dimensions.

TIMING SYSTEM RULES	•	Automatic timing (touch pads primary) will be used. Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet.
RULES		All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are
		subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
	•	No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted.
	•	In compliance with <i>USA Swimming Rules and Regulations</i> , the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.
	•	Deck changes are prohibited.
	•	Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
	•	Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
	•	Dive-over starts will be used.
	•	The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.
EVENT RULES	•	All events are timed finals.
	•	All events will be seeded fastest to slowest.
	•	Swimmers may enter no more than three (3) events per session and no more than seven (7) total events for the meet.
	•	12&U Swimmers may only participate in ONE session per day. They may not participate in the Open session if they are competing in the Saturday 12&U session
	•	LCM times are preferred; SCY times will be considered non-conforming and seeded after LCM. Coaches' times and converted times will be accepted.
	•	Event #1, Mixed Open 1500m Free, will be seeded fastest to slowest as a consolidated gender event. If excessive entries are submitted, the event will be limited to the fastest seeded 40 athletes or 4 heats total. If a swimmer is removed, they will not be charged for the event.
		 Entries are limited to those swimmers who have a provable BB time for their age group in either the 1500m/1650y Free or the 800m/1000y Free. Time conversions are acceptable for entry purposes. All entries must be in LCM. Athletes entering with an 800/1000 time will be seeded after athletes entering with a 1500m time.
	•	Swimmers in events 400m and greater must provide their own timer.

	Deck entries (\$20 surcharge plus \$20 per event) will be accepted. No new heats will be created.
	Beek entries (\$20 surenaige plus \$20 per event) will be decepted. No new heats will be created.
POSITIVE CHECK IN	All events 100m and less will be pre-seeded.
	Events 200M and longer may require positive check-in. Positive check-in will be available during
	the warm-up of the session an event is swum and will close 10 minutes prior to the start of the session.
WARM-UP	 1500M Freestyle positive check-in will close 20 minutes prior to the start of the event. The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director
	will determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.
SUPERVISION	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and for cleaning up their team areas.
	Marshals will be on deck to help direct traffic and maintain order.
SEEDING	All events will be seeded fastest to slowest.
SCORING	This meet will not be scored.
AWARDS	There are no awards for this meet.
PROGRAMS	Programs will be provided free of charge via .pdf files on the FISH website and available on Meet Mobile.

CREDENTIALS	Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be
	permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming
	membership with them. Deck Pass, live screen, is an acceptable form of proof.
SPECTATOR ENTRY FEE	None.
	• Limited, single event only spectator viewing will be allowed in the standing room only area in
	the stands once volunteer requirements have been met. Marshals will clear the area in
	between events.
MEDICAL ASSISTANCE	Medical assistance will be provided by the facility staff. If you require medical assistance, please
	notify a facility lifeguard or a member of the meet staff.
OFFICIALS	• Each participating club is requested to provide at least one table worker or official (Referee Starter, Chief Judge or Stroke & Turn Judge) per session if entering 25 or more splashes.
