  9 swim meets.


#### 1st Swim Meet of the Year: Black & Gold Meet

- Everybody swims every event, where possible.





## How to declare your swimmers for swim meets?

#### When To Sign-Up For a Swim Meet?

#### **Dual Meets:**

Online Sign-up, this closes 48 hours before the meet.

• If you miss deadline - Talk directly with Coach Charis after online sign-up closes.

Madison Medal Meet – Saturday June 17th, 2023 (optional)

- Choose 5 Events (see website for events)
- •\$5.00/event + \$5 surcharge
- •Online Meet Entry Deadline Sunday the 13th of June

#### District – 7 & 8th of July \*Every swimmer has a chance to qualify for state!

- Choose 3 Individual Events (under discretion of the Coaches)
- Meet Fees already included in registration
- Indicate availability for Relays

## ARPA STATE MEET

- State Qualifying Time (SQT) See website for times . Swimmers with SQT advance to State, including 6&U
- Top 4 regardless of time advance to State
   9 Relays per age group advance from
   District 2
- Mixed relays Each age group will have a mixed free relay and mixed medley relay.
- Mixed relays must consist of <u>two males and</u> <u>two females</u> from the same age group or one age group below.

#### Swimmer Conduct



• Good behavior is expected of swimmers at all times, especially when practicing with the team, using facilities, equipment, and representing the team at a meet.



• Respect the Wellness and Aquatic center at all times!



Be respectful of patrons exiting the facility as CST is entering for swim meets.

Home and Away Meets	Additional Home Meet Opportunities
Timers- 16 (8 per half) Records the swimmer's time.	Head Timer-2 (1 per half) In charge of lane timers during the meet.
Ribbon/Merchandise- 2 (1 per half) This job will be appointed and reserved for families that have communicated a specific need for this role.	Runner- 2 (1 per half) Responsible for taking lane timer sheets per event to scoring table.
Place Judge- 2 (1 per half) Judges the order of swimmers finishing the races.	Bullpen-6 (3 per half) Organizes swimmers per event, heat, and lane and ensuring they are ready for their race.



# Please Sign and Return the Parent Code of Conduct Form



#### Parent Code of Conduct and Acknowledgment of Responsibilities

I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for my child participating in the Cullman Park and Recreation Cullman Swim and Dive Team by following this Parents Code of Conduct pledge.

We feel that parents play a vital role in the development of all swimmers and divers, therefore, we believe in the following:

- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all participants, Coaches, Officials, Board Members, and Staff at a team-sponsored event either at home or away.
- I will place the emotional, psychological, and physical well-being of my child, and any other child on my team ahead of any personal desires I may have.
- 3. I will insist that my child participates in a safe and healthy environment.
- I will support all coaches, board members, and others working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- 5. I will accept that striving to win is more important than winning itself.
- 6. I will remember that the team is for the youth and not for adults.
- I will ask my child to treat other participants, coaches, board members, parents, and spectators with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.
- I will, along with any guest of mine, refrain from any and all vulgar, lewd, or obscene language or gestures while participating in, or watching any team-sponsored event whether at home or away.
- 9. Be a positive role model through my own actions to make sure my child has the best athletic experience possible.
- 10. Be a "team" fan, not a "my kid" fan.
- 11. Show respect for the opposing swimmers, divers, coaches, spectators, and support groups.
- 12. Be respectful of all officials' decisions.
- 13. Don't instruct your children before or after a meet, because it may conflict with the coach's plans and strategies.
- 14. Praise swimmers/divers in their attempt to improve themselves as students, athletes, and as people.
- 15. Gain an understanding and appreciation for the rules of the contest.
- 16. Recognize and show appreciation for an outstanding swim by either team.
- 17. If you as a parent have a concern or an unforeseen issue arises during a swim meet, take time to talk with coaches in an appropriate manner including the proper time and place. Be sure to follow the designated chain of command.
- 18. Please reinforce our drug, alcohol, and tobacco-free policies by refraining from the use of any substances before and during athletic events.
- 19. I will direct all comments and criticisms of parents, participants, officials, board members, and coaches away from the children participating on the team, and conduct myself in a calm, civilized manner when doing so.
- 20. I will respect the Cullman Swim and Dive Team rules and regulations, and agree to abide by those rules, responsibilities, and Code of Conduct. Violations of these rules could result in disciplinary action up to and including permanent dismissal from the Cullman Swim Team.
- 21. I acknowledge that I will NOT post anything on any platform of social media that shows any level of negativity towards any player, coach, parent, referee, or team.
- 22. I understand that my participation by volunteering at the swim meet is a vital part of being part of this team.
- 23. I understand I must volunteer a minimum of 5 times during the season and am encouraged to volunteer at both home and away meets (swim team families only.)
- 24. I understand that if I do not meet the volunteer requirements a fee of \$300.00 will be charged to my account at the end of the season (swim team families only.)

In order to participate in the Cullman Swim and Dive Team, this form must be signed and dated. Failure of the parent or guardian to read and sign this form will automatically render the parent ineligible to participate in the team activities at home or away. In addition, by signing this form, the signee agrees to abide by the guidelines set forth in the Code of Conduct and Acknowledgement of Responsibilities form. Also, by signing, you agree to be responsible for the actions and conduct of yourself and anyone who attends to watch the participant related to this form.
