Mechanicsburg Swim Club Team Members will...

- *Treat leaders who may be coaches, board members, officials or other parents with respect.
- *Treat pool facilities, pool equipment and others property with respect
- *Respect other athletes and your opponents. Be a positive part of the team. Respect and support team members
- *While on deck, swimmers are to listen to the coaches at all times. Talk with your Coach if you have any difficulties or do not understand something.
- *No goofing off, horseplay, or other dangerous activities in or around pools and locker rooms.
- *Be fair at all times.
- *Understand swimming can be hard work and requires you to come to practice and pay attention to your coaches to achieve your goals. Do your best to achieve your goals.
- *Never bully or use bullying actions (physical, verbal or emotional) against another person
- *Listen to and respect decisions made by others; if you feel unjustly treated you and your parents can talk to your Coach/Coaches.
- *Talk to an adult if you are upset or angry or if someone has caused you to be upset or angry.
- *Never use violence or bad language, and do not shout or argue with leaders, teammates or opposing team members
- *Commit to attending at least 2 practices a week. If other commitments prevent this, you will communicate this to coaching staff as quickly as possible. You acknowledge that an inability to attend regularly will require a conversation with the coaches to decide the appropriate practice group or lane to ensure consistent training and instruction. (Long term illness and injury absences will be assessed on an individual basis by the coaching staff, and appropriate training groups will be assigned to help best ensure a safe return to your season.)

If a swim club member fails to comply with the code of conduct potential disciplinary actions may be required and will be handled on a case by case basis by the board and include parents and coaches as appropriate.
