WCST Season Notes



- Your swimmer is automatically signed-in to all meets by default!
- To sign-out your swimmer, follow instructions on our website:
 - tab labeled "Jobs-Meet Sign-Outs"
- For dual meets, sign-out your swimmer at least 8 days prior to meet.
- For invitational meets, sign-out by deadline which will be emailed.
- If you attend City Meet (with children under 15), you are required to work at least 1 job shift at that meet.

WCST Parent Jobs



- Recreational Swim is only possible with YOUR support!
 - ALL our work is for the benefit of the swimmers
- The number of jobs required per family is applicable this season.
 - We are back to pre-pandemic format
 - Plan to sign up for 8-9 jobs plus 2 jobs at Crossings Challenge
 - Jobs will open for signup on Saturday, May 7 in the evening.
 - Exact details will be communicated in advance.
- You must sign up for your **jobs on our website** as before
 - Instructions found by clicking on tab "Jobs / Meets Sign-Outs"
 - Sign up early to get the jobs you want
 - Sign up for ALL your required jobs ASAP
 - Meet Directors will monitor that everyone commits to their share.
- There are **penalties** associated to missed job assignment(s)
 - First time => \$50 fine due immediately
 - Second time => swimmer not allowed to participate in team activities until all fines are paid.

WCST Parent Jobs



- Crossings Challenge (Invitational hosted by WCST) requires ALL hands on deck. To be held July 8-9.
 - Every family must work 2 jobs at this event
- **Substitutes** (for any meet) may be used to perform any of your jobs.
 - There are exceptions: Officials, Data Team, Announcer
 - 15 or older for Kitchen, Setup/Takedown
 - 12 or older for timing, marshal,...
 - We keep a list of teenagers willing to substitute

Job Types

- Timer: three per lane
- Ribbon filers: put ribbons into family folders
- Marshal: Organize/line younger swimmers for the upcoming heats
- Setup/Takedown: all equipment needed for the meet
- Floater: relieves other jobs and/or other miscellaneous tasks
- Runner: collect disqualification slips and timer slips and delivers to desk
- Announcer: Announce each event/heat and any other information
- Kitchen: Assist with food preparation and sales

Special Job Areas

No substitutes allowed

- Officials Team (Stroke & Turn Judges, Starter, & Head Referee)
 - Training is required for new officials
 - Will schedule with you individually (not through job sign-ups)
 - You may need to sign up for additional jobs to meet your requirement
- Data Team Assistant (Computers, scoreboard, printers)
 - Must work as many Home Meets as possible
 - You many need to sign up for additional jobs to meet your requirement
- These jobs guarantee best view of the races!
