MEET MANAGER NOTES

July 1, 2010

Meet Setup

- 1. Open the correct database
 - a. File...Open...Dual Meet Template
- 2. Customize the meet information
 - a. Setup...Meet Setup
 - i. Edit meet information
 - Date of Meet
 - Meet Style...2 Team Dual
 - Course...<your pool: SC Meters or Yards>
 - b. Setup...Meet Seeding
 - i. Basic: Timed Finals = Standard
 - ii. Dual Meet: Click and drag team name to odd/even lanes; select "Use Lane Assignments Above"
 - Alternate Use of Unassigned Lane (2 team dual): For 2 team duals only and in cases where there is no team assigned to a lane in the menu above, such as in a 5 or 7 lane pool, the empty extra lane will alternate by event as to which team will fill it.
 - c. Global Changes (e.g. number of lanes)
 - i. Setup...Options...Global
 - # of lanes
 - Event fees (also see below)
 - ii. Setup...Entry/Scoring Preferences
 - # of places to award
 - Entry/Entry Limits (# events, time since date)
 - Point system (e.g. to award points for time improvement)
- 3. Set the meet entry fees
 - a. Setup...Option...Global (event fees)
 - b. Reports...Team Reports...Entry Fee Summary (athlete, team, and facility surcharge)
- 4. Remove entries & results ("reset")
 - a. File...Purge...Remove Data Selectively...Entries/Results
- 5. Verify the meet events
 - a. Event numbering
 - b. Lanes
 - c. Scored events: all should be "yes" except for 6&U events would should be "no"
- 6. Set/Verify the entry limit
- 7. Import Entries
 - a. Age-up swimmers
 - b. Generate Entry List report for each team
 - i. Reports...Entry List...
- 8. Seed Events
- 9. Session Setup
 - a. Edit information
 - i. Meet Start Time
 - ii. Time between heats (typ. 30-45 sec between heats; extra 15-30 sec for backstroke)
 - b. Time Line: Events...Session...<double click>...edit info
- 10. Export TM Event file for the meet
 - a. Export Events to TM...(Allow course conversion)

11. Importing Entries and Seeding the Meet

- a. Friday
 - i. Import each team's entries into MM
 - ii. Generate a meet entry report PDF for each team (only show their team). Send the PDF to each coach and have them verify their entries
 - iii. Seed the meet
 - iv. You might want to print/PDF a Heat Sheet and Timeline report to see where you are to get a heads up.

b. Saturday

- i. Make any last minute changes, finish by 8:30am
- ii. Reseed the meet.
- iii. Look for stragglers in heat 1. For dual meets, MM will allow a solo swimmer in heat 1. Manually adjust the seeding (RUN...<select event>...ADJUST) by pulling the outside lanes from the next heat back to heat 1; manually drag and drop each swimmer, seeding lanes by time. So you now should have 3 swimmers in heat 1.
- iv. Print/PDF a Heat Sheet. Final check.
- v. Print 3-5 copies of the heat sheet. Referee/Starter, 1 for each team/coach, etc.
- vi. Print entry card labels. Print by team.
- vii. Print remaining heat sheets

12. Reports

- a. Meet Time Line (and number of heats): Reports...Session
- b. Heat Sheet: Reports...Meet Program

Running the Meet

- Displaying Backup times (in RUN mode)
 - RUN: Preferences...Run Screen...Show Backup Times
- Combining Events (e.g. 6&U with 8&U), when in RUN mode
 - Finish and SCORE the 6&U event
 - Print award labels
 - Finish the 8&U event
 - Print award labels

Note: if you do not print labels before combining event, any 6&U who places top 8 will also be included in the 8&U awards labels. By rule, a swimmer in a 6&U event who places top 8 in the 8&U event will earn points but not an additional (i.e. 8&U) ribbon. This applies to the backstroke and freestyle events.

- Combine the 6&U event with the 8&U
 - Highlight/Select the 8&U event (this makes the 8&U the default Target Event)
 - RUN: Combine...
 - Source Event = 6&U (e.g. 9)
 - Target Event = 8&U (e.g. 11)
 - Select (bottom button) Copy Events to Target Event and <u>leave Source Results</u>

Unchanged

- SCORE the 8&U event
- Changing heats/lanes for a swimmer
 - Use the <Adjust> button to drag and drop swimmers between lanes/heats
- Entering Times for events
 - Enter the times from the cards
 - Use the <Calc> button to have MM calculate the final time
- Scoring the Events/Meet
 - As you "run" the meet and enter events, select <SCORE> after you finish the results for each event. The event status wil change from "Done" to "Scored".
 - MM will automatically keep a running score
- Printing Event Results and Award Labels
- Printing/Sending Meet Results (PDF file)
- Finalizing Meet Results
 - Verify that all seeded events are "Scored" (except 6&U which should only be "Done")
 - Print the results. Reports...Results
 - Columns/Format
 - Columns = Single
 - Format...Relay Names = 4
 - Include in Results
 - Select: Time Stds, Entry Times, No Shows
 - Include Team Scores
 - Select: Combined, Male, Female
 - Splits/Sort Order/Selected Teams
 - Sort Order = Session Order
 - Selected Teams = All Teams
 - Export TM results for each team. File...Export...Results for Team Manager or SWIMS or NCAA Database
 - Select each team separately and save the TM results (.zip) file
- Send the MM Backup File to the CMSL Statistician
 - Backup the database. File...Backup. When backing up the database, do <u>not</u> select "lock" the database

Changing Meet Results from SCM <-> SCY

Suppose you run a meet setup as Yards and enter results, but the meet is actually in short course meters. The results will be stored with an S denoting short course meters. To change the course for the results to yards, you must use the sessions to menu to do this.

There are three scenarios:

- No Sessions are Setup: Add one session with the wrong course and move all events into the session. Then edit the session and change the course to the correct session. MM will offer the option to change all the results for that session to the new course.
- Sessions are setup with the wrong course (this is the one you want): Edit each session and change to the correct course. MM will offer the option to change all the results for each session to the new course.
 - Events...Sessions...Edit...<select course>. Change from Yards to SCM and say <yes> to change all events
- Sessions are setup with the correct course, but the results course is still wrong: Edit each session and change to an incorrect course. Edit each session again and change to the correct course. MM will offer the option to change all the results for each session to the new course.

Scoring the Meet

Normal Event Scoring

- Setup...Scoring Setup...Standard
 - · Enter the points for individual and relays
- Setup...Entry / Scoring Setup
 - Scoring / Awards (tab)
 - Select the number of places to award

As you "run" the meet and enter events, MM will automatically keep a running score Hy-Tek Points (USAS)

Calculates strength-of-swim points, based on the national database/scoring system

- Setup...Entry / Scoring Preferences
 - Scoring / Awards (tab)
 - Special Points Systems (drop down)
 - Hy-Tek Age Group Points
- Scoring
 - Run...Rescore...Yes (select all events)
- Exporting Results
 - Reports...Scores
 - Format (tab)
 - Points = Std Points
 - Export as excel file

Improvement Points (for Team Use)

Awards 1 point for every 1st time swim and time improvement

- Setup...Entry / Scoring Preferences
 - Improvements (tab)
 - Table Entries
 - -99.00 through 00.00 = 0
 - 0.01 through 99.00 = 1
 - Points Awarded if NT = 1
 - Points Awarded if Exh = ✓
 - Scoring / Awards (tab)
 - Special Points Systems (drop down)
 - · Improvement Points
- Scoring
 - Run...Rescore...Yes (select all events)
- Exporting Results
 - Reports...Scores
 - Format (tab)
 - Points = Std Points
