

How to print out a CMSL Record Broken Form for the Official to sign.


 When you print out the form, you want to make sure that only the CMSL record shows up on the form, not any additional pool records. Bill does not like this.
In TouchPad, from the home page select Events.



2. In Events, select the Event Records button.



3. 3. Now, in our case we want to keep the CMSL-Y (yards) records (circled in yellow). If you are in a meters pool, obviously you want to keep the CMSL-M records. I also have our pool records for meets, so I need to delete those in order for them not to show up on the records broken form. So, select the Delete button to remove any team records you might have. If you don't have team records, then you can skip this step.




4. Now, go back to the TouchPad home page and select Meet Results.

5. Select Type of Results: Records Broken. Make sure you have all the content included that you need. We have ours set up as below. Format to one column. In User Defined Sessions: Active Session: select NO SESSION USED. Then, on the bottom right corner, enter the event number you have the record broken in both the Start and End events.



6. Your print out should like like the one below. Print this page and have the official sign it. Then, include a picture of the signed form with your meet results that you send to the league statistician.
