TEAM PHILOSOPHY

- We want to help every swimmer develop a love for the sport of swimming.
- We believe that it is important that we expose all the swimmers to all of the strokes and encourage everyone to try every event.
- We focus on quality and not quantity.
- We want to encourage communication with the coaches. This includes issues such as leaving meets early, questions about DQs and what is going on at practice.

PRACTICE TIMES AND GROUPS FOR 2023

- Broken up by abilities instead of ages
- It's up to the parents to decide what group your swimmer belongs to.
- Price reflects not only time, but number of coaches on deck.
- We will work with parents to make sure all the swimmers are in the correct group.

GOLD GROUP

- Gold AM time- 6:20 am to 7:40 am Monday-Friday
- Open to swimmers 13+. Special permission can be granted by the Head Coach for younger, advanced swimmers
- 2-3 coaches on deck
- Swimmers should expect to swim around 2500 meters a day

PURPLE GROUP

- Purple AM time- 7:40 am to 8:40 am Mon-Friday
- ***We are adding 2 lanes of Purple 6:40 to 7:40***
- Open to all ages, recommended for intermediate swimmers and swimmers in the 9-12 age group (swimmers who can swim for the whole hour)
- Since this is our biggest group, if you are flexible please consider going to the Gold group or in the evenings. Especially in the first couple of weeks.
- 5-6 coaches on deck
- Swimmers swim approx. 1500 meters

GREEN GROUP

- Green AM time- 8:40 am to 9:30 am Monday-Friday
- Open to all ages, recommended for beginning swimmers and younger (8 and under) swimmers *must be able to swim a 25 without touching the side*
- 5-6 coaches on deck
- Distance depends on swimmers ability

INTRO TO MARLINS GROUP

- Tues/Thurs PM time- 5:30pm to 6:15 and 6:15 to 7:00pm
- Restricted to age 10 and under, recommended for beginning swimmers or swimmers looking to check out what summer club swimming is all about.
- 2 coaches per lane
- Limited to 12 swimmers per group (6 per lane)
- Hopefully, the swimmers will feel comfortable trying out 1 meet.
- Distance depends on swimmers ability

TUES/THURS NIGHT PRACTICE

- Tues/Thurs PM time- 5:30 to 7:00 pm
- Open to all groups for swimmers who want to work on technique or make up practice.
- 6 lanes will be split into stroke work and regular practice depending on needs of the swimmers
- 3-4 coaches on the deck
- Distance depends on swimmers ability

SPLASH AT FOSSIL TRACE

- We rent the pool from the City of Golden. Which means we will follow the City of Golden rules.
- Pools are going to have very different rules. Just because AK can do something doesn't mean we can.
- We need to remember that the Marlins are just one of the patrons of pool. We have a great relationship with them and we want to keep it that way.

WEATHER

- Colorado weather is hard to predict.
- We won't cancel practice unless we are 100% certain Splash will be closed.
- It can be pouring rain at 5:30 and sunny at 6:00 (this has happened more times than I can count.)
- The pool is heated, so we will have practice regardless of the outside temp.
- We respect you as a parent to decide if the weather is ok for your swimmer.

MEETS

- State has been moved up one week this year. So it is July 19th 21st.
- You will still sign your swimmer up for events using the website. (For more info, see "Parent's page" on our website.
- Most meets are Saturday morning. They start early and are done before noon. The official schedule is on the website.
- Meets take a lot of people to run smoothly (and quickly). We need lots of parent help.

VOLUNTEERING

- The Marlins are great because of our Parents.
- Best way to see your kid swim is to volunteer at swim meets. (Officials get to see every event!)
- There are a lot of opportunities to volunteer if you can't volunteer at meets. Check the website.
- Each family is required to volunteer for 3 sessions.
 - One session is a timing shift, concessions shift, setup/cleanup shift, etc.
 - Full season opportunities are also available
 - Officials, heating, volunteer coordinator, etc.
- To make sure everyone does their part, we ask that every family writes a \$250 "check" (We use your saved credit card). We only charge the card the end of the season if the family does not complete the volunteer requirements.

REGISTRATION

- Register on the website using the "Registration" button in the upper right.
- Discounts for multiple athletes from the same family. No discounts for the "Intro to Marlins" program.
- Does not include gear.
- No additional fees for meets.
- Fees:
 - Gold, Purple, Green Groups: \$235, \$35 discount per sibling
 - 1st swimmer: \$235, 2nd: \$200, 3rd: \$165, etc.
 - Intro to Marlins: \$160, no sibling discount
- No Refunds after May 31st.

REGISTRATION

- Opens Wednesday, 4/10, at 7:00am for returning families. "Returning Family" status is by family, not swimmer. New swimmers from returning families can register on 4/11.
- Opens Thursday, 4/11, at 7:00am for new families.
- Please provide and verify your cell phone number. This is how we can contact you in case of an emergency.
- We will close registration when we fill up. We want to make sure that everyone on the team has a positive experience. So, we want to keep the number of swimmers per lane manageable.








- Required Gear
