TIMERS INFORMATION

Each lane will have three (3) timers assigned to. There should never be more than one (1) Aqua Jets timer timing in a lane that the Aqua Jets is swimming. There should never be more than two (2) Aqua Jets timers timing in a lane that the visiting team is swimming in. The only exception to this may be the Wednesday Development meets.

Timers should attend the Head Timer meeting called approximately 30 minutes before the start of the meet.

Before the heat begins, timers should verify that the swimmer and the name on the timing card matches. If they do not have the correct card then should contact the Head Timer.

Timers must start their watches on the strobe light (not the sound) and stop their watch when any part of the swimmer touches the wall.

They will write down the times and circle the middle time.

If they have a watch malfunction or fail to start their watch, they must raise their hand to signal the head timer to swap watches with them.

Timers must start their watches even if they do not have a card and write down times.

Timers should not clear their watches until the next heat is whistled. Timers are expected to work the entire meet.
