



Barrington Blue Fins: Supervision of Younger Swimmers at Swim Team Practices, Meets, and Events

- The Barrington Pool rules state that children 11 and older may swim at the pool unaccompanied by a parent or responsible adult only if they pass the basic swim test (conducted by the lifeguard). The swim test consists of competently swimming the length of the pool without stopping and treading in deep water continuously for one minute. The Barrington Blue Fins Swim Team also abides by this policy.
- Parents/guardians are not allowed to drop off their swimmers and leave them unsupervised at practices, meets and events. Supervision can be in the form of a parent/guardian, daycare provider, or a designated minor who is 16 years or older and is responsible for the swimmer.
- This form must be signed by the parent/guardian and the designated supervisor (adult/minor who is 16 years or older). Please give this form to the Head Coach of the Barrington Blue Fins on the first day of practice.
