## **Hamlin Hammerheads General Information – 2025**

### REGISTRATION FEES / MERCHANDISE

- Registration for **returning** members (and siblings of returning members) is March 1<sup>st</sup> March 8<sup>th</sup>. (May register thru March 24<sup>th</sup>, but opens to all residents on March 9<sup>th</sup>)
- Registration for **new** members is March 9<sup>th</sup>-24<sup>th</sup>. Please note that we will do our best to accommodate all new members. However, there are several age groups that are quite large such as 7-8 girls, 9-10 girls, and 11-12 girls. Once these age group reach capacity, we will start a wait list.

- The registration costs are:
  - 1 swimmer \$125
  - **2** swimmers \$250
  - **3** swimmers \$325
  - 4 or more swimmers \$400
- Team swimsuits may be purchased directly from **Blue Sky Endurance**. They will be at the Hamlin clubhouse on Sunday, March 23<sup>rd</sup> from 2-4pm. You will be able to have your swimmer be fitted for the correct size suit and also purchase your suit. If you cannot attend this day, you may purchase your swimmer's suit at Blue Sky Endurance located at The Bend in Carolina Park by Costco from March 24<sup>th</sup> until April 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Hamlin Swim caps will also be available for purchase at the swimsuit try-on session and throughout the season thru Paige. They are \$12 a piece.
- Unfortunately, Chlorine Deckwear has paused its swim store. We are looking at options for team gear and will send out information as soon as it is finalized.

#### PRACTICE SCHEDULE

Tryouts for **new** swimmers to make sure your swimmer is safe in the water will be Wednesday afternoon, **May 7**<sup>th</sup> **at 5:00pm**. 5/6's and 7/8's must be able to swim one length of the pool and 9/10's must be able to swim at least 2 lengths of the pool. If your swimmer was not on the team last year, tryouts are required unless you have discussed with Paige Hall.

  head coach.
- Make-up meets due to inclement weather are typically on the following Monday.
- Meets cannot happen without volunteers! **Parents are expected to volunteer three times a season to help with meets**. A list of volunteer positions and what it entails will be emailed out

after the season starts, and the volunteer positions will be posted on our team unify page to sign up.

- 5-6-year-old Championship meet will be on **June 24<sup>th</sup> or 25th** at TBA location. The date and location will be decided at the East Cooper Swim League Board meeting and more information will be available as the season progresses.

If you are not able to go to this meet, please let the coaches or board know in advance, if a swimmer does not show up it affects the ability to have relay teams and races will be cancelled. Do **NOT** assume your swimmer **will not go** to champs unless told by the coach.
- The season concludes with the end of year banquet on **Tuesday**, **July 1**<sup>st</sup> and will be held at the clubhouse, more information to come as the event gets closer.
