Constitution and By-Laws

Constitution

Article I-Name

- Section 1 The official name of the parents club will be:
Nazareth Area High School Swimming & Diving Team Booster Club

Article II-Purpose

- Section 1 Supporting and encouraging the team spirit and physical development of students participating in the swimming & diving program at Nazareth Area High School.
- Section 2 Collaborating with the school administration in developing plans and activities to assist and enhance the swimming & diving programs at Nazareth Area High School, including the improvement of equipment and facilities.
- Section 3 Encouraging parents/guardians and the public to recognize the efforts and accomplishments of the swimming & diving programs of the Nazareth Area School District students and their coaches.
- Section 4 Providing financial support through fund raising activities as deemed necessary and appropriate by the membership.

Article III-Membership

- Section 1 Parents of any child that is a member of the Nazareth Area High School Swimming and Diving team or any affiliate swimming and diving team that practices with the Nazareth team are automatic members of the booster club. The organization may also consist of anyone age 21 or older that is a member of the Nazareth Community that has an interest in supporting the endeavors of the organization, as well as the coaches involved with the team. Full voting privileges, however, belong only to the parents of all swimmers and divers of the Nazareth Area High School Swimming and Diving Team, as well as the head coach. Each family will receive one vote only, regardless of the number of participants they have on the team. There is no membership fee required.

Article IV-Organization

- Section 1 The officers of this club will consist of a President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer. These officers will be elected by the general membership in accordance with the procedures defined in the By-Laws.
- Section 2 Committee Chairs will be appointed by the officers in order to lead and direct activities and events as deemed necessary. Committee Members will be recruited from within the general membership.
- Section 3 The general membership will meet monthly or as needed, and act on business brought before it by the officers or any member of the club.

Article V-Amendments

- Section 1 The President shall distribute, via e-mail or by posting on the website and informing of the membership by e-mail, a copy of the proposed amendments 10 days prior to a general membership meeting. The Constitution and By-Laws may be amended by a 2/3 vote of the general membership at any general membership meeting, and following those procedures contained in Robert's Rules of Order (11th edition) p. 592-599.
