

Santa Margarita Catholic High School Rancho Santa Margarita, CA *Presenter: Richard Blanc* Leadership and Service Led the efforts to present, design, fundraise, and oversee construction of a \$4.5 million aquatics complex at Santa Margarita Catholic High School; Created the idea, presented the fiscal plan, purchased, and operated a 9' X 22" full-color HD video board and scoreboard for the aquatics center at Santa Margarita Catholic High School (2015-2016); Began and continued the first California Catholic School Swim Challenge bringing the best Catholic high school swim teams from Northern, Central, and Southern California for a one day invitational (2010 to present); Wrote and published a 72 page media guide highlighting the current high school swimming and diving team and school aquatics history for release to local press agencies and college swimming and diving coaches (1989 to present); Created and mailed (now emailed) the Santa Margarita Catholic Recruiting Newsletter sent to over 100 college swimming and diving coaches annually (1998 to present). Founded and developed the present-day Trinity League of Swimming and Diving (formerly the Angelus League, then Serra League) in 1990.

26 team State Championships: 24 girls. 2 boys. 16 consecutive girls team State Championships: an Ohio IIS all-sport. all-division record and an open, ongoing streak at the time of retirement; Career dual meet record: 658-117-2: 85%, winning percentage; 8 time Ohio Coach of the Year; member of Hawken School Athletic Hall of Fame; Member of Ohio High School Swimming Coaches Association Hall of Fame; Member of American Swimming Coaches Hall of Fame; member of Cleveland Sports Hall of Fame; 48 team District Championships. 32 girls. 16 boys - first title was 1976 boys; 4 Chagrin Valley Conference Championships since it began in 1996; 82 individual and 49 relay State Championship events won; A total of 131 events won at the State Meet; 39 different swimmers won an individual State Championship; 45 more swimmers were on State Champion relay teams; 329 top-four finishes in individual and relay events at the State Meet; 77 different swimmers earned a top finish in individual events; dozens more did so as part; of a relay team Hawken girls won the 400 free relays at States 19. times since its first in in 1984; Hawken girls won all 3 relay events at the State meet in eight of Jerry's final 14 year: Five of the 11 OHSAA Girls Division n Swimming records were held by Hawken swimmers in Jerry's final year; Coached two Olympic Gold Medalists: Melanic Valerio '87. Diana Munz; Coached Erica Rose '2000. Open Water World Champion; Coached hundreds of All-Americans; Coach / Director of nationally recognized Lake Eric Silver Dolphins swimming Club; Chagrin Valley conference Coach of the Year multiple times; Plain Dealer Coach of the Year multiple times; The Holtrey Pool Hawken School's Gates Mills Campus Natatorium is named in his honor.
