TEAM WORKER ASSIGNMENTS

January 26, 2025

All Team Workers must check-in at the Worker Table that will be located on the main concourse of the aquatic center Spectator Level, near the main entrance. Once the workers have been checked-in they will be given a wristband that will allow them to be on the Deck Level for the duration of their work shift. **No one will be allowed on the pool deck without proper credentials or wristbands, all spectators must remain on the Spectator Level.**

There will be a Team Worker meeting at 8:10 AM for Preliminary Session and 5:30 PM for Finals Session. These meetings will be held on the pool deck level and workers should plan to check-in early enough to insure they can be on the deck by the meeting start time.

Team worker assignments are for the duration of that session. Many teams choose to break up their assignment into 'shifts' so that their workers do not have to work the entire session. In this case, all 'first shift' workers must attend the worker meeting prior to the beginning of the session. Second shift workers may either check-in at same time as First shift workers or they must check-in at the Worker Table which will be open from 10:10-10:30 AM. The First Shift workers must remain at their positions until relieved.

LANE TIMER- Each team should provide **two** timers for their lane during prelims and **one** timer for finals.

Workers on Diving Well End are required for both Preliminary and Final sessions while workers on the Scoreboard End are only required for Preliminary session.
