

## Coppermine Site Details

We welcome you to our facility for the sessions jointly hosted by Rock Spring and Coppermine Bel Air. The following is a list of things to be familiar with to make for an easier and more enjoyable experience. Please be familiar with the site plan. We did apply lessons learned from last year to make this a more enjoyable experience for all.

### **Parking and Entry**

Sunday-Parking attendants will be available; follow their directions. Parking is available in the following places:

- 1) Behind Steel fish
- 2) Enter Via Gateway Dr and park in the spaces to the right of the club as you face the front. (By Life-med and Medstar)
- 3) Behind Old Wilmer Eye off Gateway Dr.
- 4) The Mall (DO NOT PARK IN CORNER LOT OF TOLLGATE AND BOLTON STREET WHERE BRADS IS SET UP!!!!)

Drop off may occur in the circle in front of Kid Sports.

Enter the facility at the gates on camp field behind Steelfish or the Gates at bottom of the hill off Gateway Dr. DO NOT USE THE FRONT DOOR TO ENTER OR PARK IN ANY SPACES PARELLEL TO THE CLUB!!!!

Parking at the following places will get you towed:

In Front of Steelfish

Corner lot of Tollgate and Bolton St at mall

The gates will not be open for entry until 6 AM

### **Team Areas and Facility**

The Facility will be closed to members. No one here for the meet is authorized to be using any pool other than the competition pool or the upper rec reserved for warm-up cool down. (THIS IS NOT A PLAY POOL!!!)

Team Areas are assigned as follows:

Coppermine, Rockspring (64): area around Instructional pool

Aqua Culture(51)- grassy Area at Deep End of Upper Rec Pool but NOT the pavilion. (This area has multiple trees providing shade so easy ups should be minimally needed but keep all easy ups off the concrete!)

Joppatowne and Emmorton (19): Pavilion near upper rec pool. Has picnic tables and shade NO EZ UPS or chairs should be required

Fountain Green (60), Fallston (43), North Harford (25), MD Golf (22), Valleybrook(22), Arena Club(65) & Aberdeen(19) will be on the back camp field with designated areas based on team size. Please bring EZ ups as teams; remember there is NOT enough area for every swimmer or family to have one. Sharing is caring! Teams on Campfield may bring them by early on Saturday evening between 8-9 PM but we assume no liability for damage.

### **Bathrooms**

Meet participants and spectators are asked to use only the following facilities for the bathroom and changing:

Lower Locker rooms off the pool deck and the bathrooms in the brown camp house on the camp field. Both locker rooms have limited changing capacity so participants are encouraged to come to the pool already changed.

The upstairs locker room and kid sports locker room are OFF limits to meet participants regardless of membership status!!!!

### **Spectators**

All spectating areas are standing only. The setting up of chairs in these areas is prohibited. The following are designated areas to spectate.

- Deck area next to lane 6
- Grassy area above the retaining wall above lane 6 deck
- Behind the white fence to the left of the start end (NO PHONE AREA)

### **Clerk of Course**

The clerk of course is behind the hot tub. Camp Field teams may access the clerk area by the steps as they walk to the pool area, all other athletes are expected to access the clerk via the opening in the splash pad. Athletes should heed calls for clerk of course and report promptly as there will be no empty lanes to place athletes in who miss their event.

NO Parents should be in the clerk of course area as that is an athlete and official area only. If you need to observe your swimmer at the clerk of course, please do so from the top of the steps.

### **Awards**

Awards ceremonies for 10 and Unders will be done at the shallow end of the Upper Rec pool in the grassy area. You may view these from the concrete area at the shallow end. Awards ceremonies will commence at the start of 13-14 50 Free and the start of 13-14 50 Back. A board with the order of ceremonies will be there. Please be respectful others viewing the awards ceremonies as well.

11 and overs may pick up awards when ceremonies are not taking place and use the awards area for a selfie station.

All awards not claimed at the end of the meet will be bagged up and given to coaches.

Every effort will be made to hold awards ceremonies but please remember actual swimming is the priority in the event predicted weather may interfere with that goal or the timeline starts running long meet management will cancel award ceremonies for 10 and unders who may pick up awards and do own self staged ceremonies.

### **Warm-up Cooldown lanes**

The upper rec pool is available for late warm-ups and cool down during the meet. This is NOT a play area. Athletes not using it for its intended purpose will be asked to get out. Athletes using this pool should be supervised by a coach. Enter the pool from the five foot end of the pool in front of Aqua Cultures team area. All entries are feet first NO DIVING is permitted.

### **Vendors and Concessions**

There will be a variety of vendors set up in the pavilion near the playground and along the walk way from the camp field.

Metro Swim Store, which will also sell meet shirts, will be on the asphalt area near Campfield.

Concessions will be available in the snack shack behind the white fence at the start end of the pool starting at 7 AM.

We cannot accommodate food deliveries for meet attendees. Do not place an order to be delivered to the club it will be turned away by front desk staff.
