## **Reports:**

Water Polo – Tim Kearney

- Broken into 2 jobs: Farrah will handle all game info, fun events etc., Tim Kearney will handle paperwork, website, new policies etc.
- o Last year about 200 kids looking at ways to increase this number as well as increase teams
- 12-14 clubs out of 27 participate in polo
- Refining the process for policies, coaches and games
- o Bringing polo in line with Midlakes operating standards documents and financials
- Have rewritten the Operating Plan
- Submitted Financial Plan
- Polo schedule set in advance this is to help clubs know if it is a 4 or 5 week cycle year
- $\circ$  Clarify communication with clubs that have a polo team and clubs without polo team
- $\circ$   $\;$  Website on the Midlakes site. Has a tab with populated links to polo

Going forward: Tim looking into future of polo ie: Why many clubs don't have teams, why teams are small, why is there a decline in High School kids, how to grow clubs in future. Midlakes is full service water sports with Swim/Dive/Polo.

# Diving – Penny Yantis

Midlakes Diving team is learning basic skills for kids and parents. Anyone on a Midlakes swim team can participate in a club that hosts a dive club and be part of the team.

#### Motion:

Motion moved to choose Option 2 (July 26<sup>th</sup>) – no second. Motion failed

Motion moved to choose Option 1 (July 12<sup>th</sup>) – seconded. Discussion:

- o Laura (Edgebrook) would like to have this discussion at 2014 Fall Meeting.
- o Clubs could have more time to talk to members about impact for team
- Pool managers operationally previous motion could decrease their expenses by 20%

Voting: 26 clubs yay – Motion passed

# 2015 League Championship Meet - Discussion

KCAC is not available on regular Midlakes calendar schedule. KCAC could allow Midlakes to rent facility on a Sunday, and have PNS Long Course Champ meet end on Saturday, July 25<sup>th</sup>, 2015. If neither option passes, board will have alternative dates/plans at 2014 Fall Meeting.

Motion moved to choose Option 1 (July 26 at KCAC) – seconded.

Amendment Motion to discuss all 3 options – seconded. Discussion:

- Midlakes needs to have fairness across board many families may not be able to participate on Sunday because of religion, and this could be construed as not being fair to those families (point of clarification – Midlakes used to rotate meets between Saturday and Sunday in the past)
- Start at noon instead of 8 am run meet later in afternoon
- Not considering this for every year
- Consider having finals at prelim meets
- PNS coaches involvement may be unable to coach final week for Midlakes
- Swimmers could be swimming at PNS Champs (KCAC is addressing this issue by ending PNS on Saturday)
- o KCAC is best facility to host so many teams not many clubs can be a host club for League Champs
- Opportunity to explore other options rather than KCAC
- Midlakes schedules around KCAC schedule Midlakes is getting first dibs to the July 26<sup>th</sup> date, if not chosen it will revert back to PNS
