

# 2015 SAVANNAH COASTAL SWIM LEAGUE RISING STAR MEET SATURDAY, JUNE 27, 2015 CHATHAM COUNTY AQUATIC CENTER

#### **EVENT**

The 2015 SCSL Rising Star will be held at the Chatham County Aquatic Center.

#### **FACILITY**

The Chatham County Aquatic center is a 25-yard, 8-lane pool with non-turbulent lane lines. A Colorado automatic timing and scoreboard will be used.

#### **MEET SCHEDULE**

- ➤ Warm-ups will begin at 8:00 AM.
- ➤ Meet Start at 9:00AM
- A timers meeting will take place near the starting area at 8:45AM.
- ➤ A mandatory coaches meeting will take place at 7:45 AM

#### **RULES**

- The intention is to provide a championship-style meet like City Meet with the non-year-round swimmer. Therefore, all City Meet rules and protocols will be observed at this meet.
- USA Swimming rules including swimsuit requirements will be followed except where Savannah Coastal Swim League rules differ or where modified in this meet information.
- Swimmers are only allowed to wear their SCSL team cap or a generic cap.
- No flash photography is permitted at the start of any event.
- With the exception of handicapped persons, no personal seating will be allowed in front of the bleacher area. No parents other than those serving in a volunteer capacity will be allowed behind the blocks or in other areas designated as being for swimmers, coaches and officials only.
- Meet management and the Chatham County Aquatic Center reserve the right to impose additional requirements to ensure the smooth operation of the event and the safety of the participants and spectators.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Only swimmers who are members of the respective teams belonging to the Savannah Coastal Swim League may participate in the meet. Only swimmers who have NOT met or swam faster



than the attached minimum times are eligible to swim in each event or relay (respective stroke for medley relays) in the Rising Star Meet. If any given swimmer has exceeded the minimum time in one event but not in another, that swimmer may only swim in the event(s) in which they have exceeded the minimum time(s). An individual may only swim in their own age group category in individual events. Please refer to the SCSL By-law, Article XI, for all regulations.

#### **ENTRY LIMIT**

All participants are limited to four individual events. All events will be conducted as timed finals.

#### **RELAYS**

Each team may enter an unlimited number of relay teams per age group in relay events. Only the top-finishing relay from each team will be scored. Relay entry cards will be provided to the coaches upon check-in before the meet. The relay teams will carry the cards with them to the starting blocks. Changes may be made up to the point where the card is handed to the timer.

#### **ENTRIES AND DEADLINES**

No deck entries will be accepted at Rising Stars meet.

#### **COACHES MTG**

There is a <u>mandatory</u> coaches meeting of all head coaches Saturday, June 27, 2015 at 7:45 AM in Aquatic Center meeting room.

#### **WARM-UP**

SCSL will enforce proper warm-up procedures and expects the cooperation of each team entered in the meet. The warm-schedule and lane assignments will be distributed to the team's coach prior to the meet. Continuous warm-ups will be permitted in the lanes not being used for competition with the exception of a buffer lane adjacent to lane 8.

#### **SCORING**

Points will be awarded for 1st – 16th places as follows:

Individual Events:

20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1

Relay Events:

36-28-24-20-16-12-8-4

In individual events, a maximum of four swimmers from any one team may score points. In relays, only one relay per team can score points.



#### **AWARDS**

**Team / Divisions** – For purposes of scoring Rising Star Meet, the league will be divided into small and large team divisions. Per SCSL bylaws updated February 2015, large teams will be determined as those teams scoring equal to or greater than the median combined total points at the previous two City Meets. The small team division will consist of the remaining teams scoring below the median total points for the last two City Meets. For the 2015 season, the large teams are IOH, LAN, MAY, RHSC, and WPST; the small teams are GL, JEA, SGC, SQCC, SYC. Trophies will be awarded to the top three (3) teams in each division based on total points from all scored events.

**Individual** - Ribbons will be awarded for first through sixteenth place.

**Relays** - Ribbons will be awarded for first through eighth place.

**High Point** - Will be awarded to the boy and girl swimmer from each age group that earns the most points for that age group. Runner-up High Point and 2nd Runner-up awards are also presented. High Point for 6 and unders will be based on points scored in the freestyle and backstroke events only.

All-star recognition will be made to the top 10 swimmers in the age categories for boys and girls: 6 and under, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, and Seniors. All-Star recognition for 6 and unders will be based on points scored in the freestyle and backstroke events only.

No team will be allowed to pick up their awards until after the treasurer has verified that all financial obligations to the league have been met.

#### **OFFICIALS**

Subject to availability, all officials participating should be USA Swimming certified and suitably qualified for the position assigned. An officials meeting will take place 30 minutes prior to start of the meet.

#### LIABILITY

The Savannah Coastal Swim League and its Board of Directors shall be free from any liabilities or claims arising by reason of injury to anyone during the conduct of the meet.

#### **CONCESSIONS**

Basic concessions will be provided. Teams will be allowed to bring coolers with food and non-alcoholic drinks. No glass containers are allowed.

#### **PARKING**

Ample parking is available in the Aquatic Center parking lots and adjacent areas.



#### **MEET WORKERS**

The Meet Director will determine the total number of workers required to run the meet. All teams are expected to provide the workers they are assigned.
