Swimmer Eligibility

State ARPA Rules: ARTICLE I – Eligibility

- A swimmer or diver cannot compete on two (2) swim teams at the same time during ARPA swimming season.



ARPA State Meet

- **State Meet Order of Events**

- Different to District Meet.
- Start with Relays.

- **State Qualifying Time (SQT) – See website for times**

- Swimmers with SQT at Districts advance to State
- Top 4 regardless of time advance to State
- 8 Relays per age group advance from District 2



Swimmer Conduct

- Good behavior is expected of swimmers and parents at all times, especially when practicing with the team, using facilities, equipment, and representing the team at a meet.
- Parents must either sit on bleachers or out on back deck during practice. Deck needs to be kept clear for coaches to move around unobstructed.
- Previous issues with poor behavior in and damage to the boys' bathrooms at Dublin.
- **Dublin Park and Rec will make the bathrooms off-limits without parent supervision if it happens again.**

- If you can't make a meet you signed up for, let us know as soon as possible so a replacement can be found.



All families help!

Requirements Per Family:

- 5 Slots per family
- New families should sign up for Blue & Gold meet to get practice
- Team parents should have 2 away meet slots
- Everybody works Medal Meet

We need people more than money!

- \$500 penalty per family if volunteer hours are not met. This fee will be charged prior to Districts.
- We need people in each position in order to run our meets. If you can't, find someone who can! If you cannot help physically & prefer to do so monetarily, please let me know ASAP so we can collect payment to help with Districts.

Volunteer Position Description

Announcer:

- Makes announcements over loudspeaker throughout the meet
- Hangs out by the computer table entire session
- Must have clear speaking voice
- Can sit down or stand, your choice

Bullpen:

- Organizes swimmers in correct lane order for their races before they go to the blocks
- Patience & loud voice are helpful

Computer Operator:

- Sits at the computer desk at side of the pool
- Makes sure computer is running correctly
- Multi-tasking skills are important



Volunteer Position Description

Computer Operator Apprentice:

- Assists the Computer Operator with making sure computer system is running smoothly throughout event
- General computer knowledge needed
- Sits behind computer table throughout the entire meet

Concessions:

- Organizes the concession stand & sells items throughout the meet.
- Will have a chance to leave and watch kids swim their races
- Seated position and can be worked with small children in your care if needed.

Hospitality:

- Helps organize the hospitality room
- Sets out food and decor to serve coaches and officials during the meet
- Will be able to leave and watch kids swim their races



Volunteer Position Description

Head Timer:

- Maintains 2 stop watches for every race
- Trades out stop watches with timers who had a timing malfunction
- Stands on the side of the pool throughout session.

Lane Timer:

- Stand at the end of the pool throughout session
- Records swimmer's time after each race as a backup to our computer timing system
- Best view of the pool the entire meet

Official Apprentice:

- Stands next to assigned official during meet on the side of the pool
- Learns about swimming rules to decide if you would like to train to be an official
- May be moved to another volunteer position if spaces are needed during the meet

Place Judge:

- Sits at the side of the pool next to the blocks the entire session
- Tracks, to the best of your ability, the order the swimmers finish their race



Volunteer Position Description

Ribbons:

- Located outside of the pool deck area. Can go watch swimmers swim their races
- Organize and label placement ribbons
- File ribbons away into file box
- Seated position and can be worked with small children in your care if needed.

Runner:

- Collects papers from the timers after every race
- Hands out ducks to heat winners (Medal Meet & Districts)
- Will stay behind blocks throughout session

Timing Console:

- Sits at the computer table throughout session
- Watches timing console to make sure it's running correctly
- Trained position - only sign up if you have worked as a timing apprentice before

Timing Console Apprentice:

- Sits at computer table throughout session
- Training on how to work the timing console
- Extra set of eyes to make sure console is running correctly



Volunteer Position Description

Meet Setup:

- Arrives to home meets early to set up equipment on the pool deck
- Some heavy lifting may be required
- Must be punctual! This position requires you to arrive at meets promptly at 3:30pm!
- This position is highly important because the equipment you will be moving and setting up is very expensive and fragile! Arriving on time and not rushing through the job is very crucial to keep this equipment from breaking or not being stored properly!

Meet Take Down:

- Will stay after meet is over to tear down and pack away pool deck items into storage closet
- Heavy lifting may be required
- This position requires you to stay after the meet sometimes up to an hour!
- This position is highly important because the equipment you will be moving and taking down is very expensive and fragile! Not rushing through the job is very crucial to keep this equipment from breaking or not being stored properly!

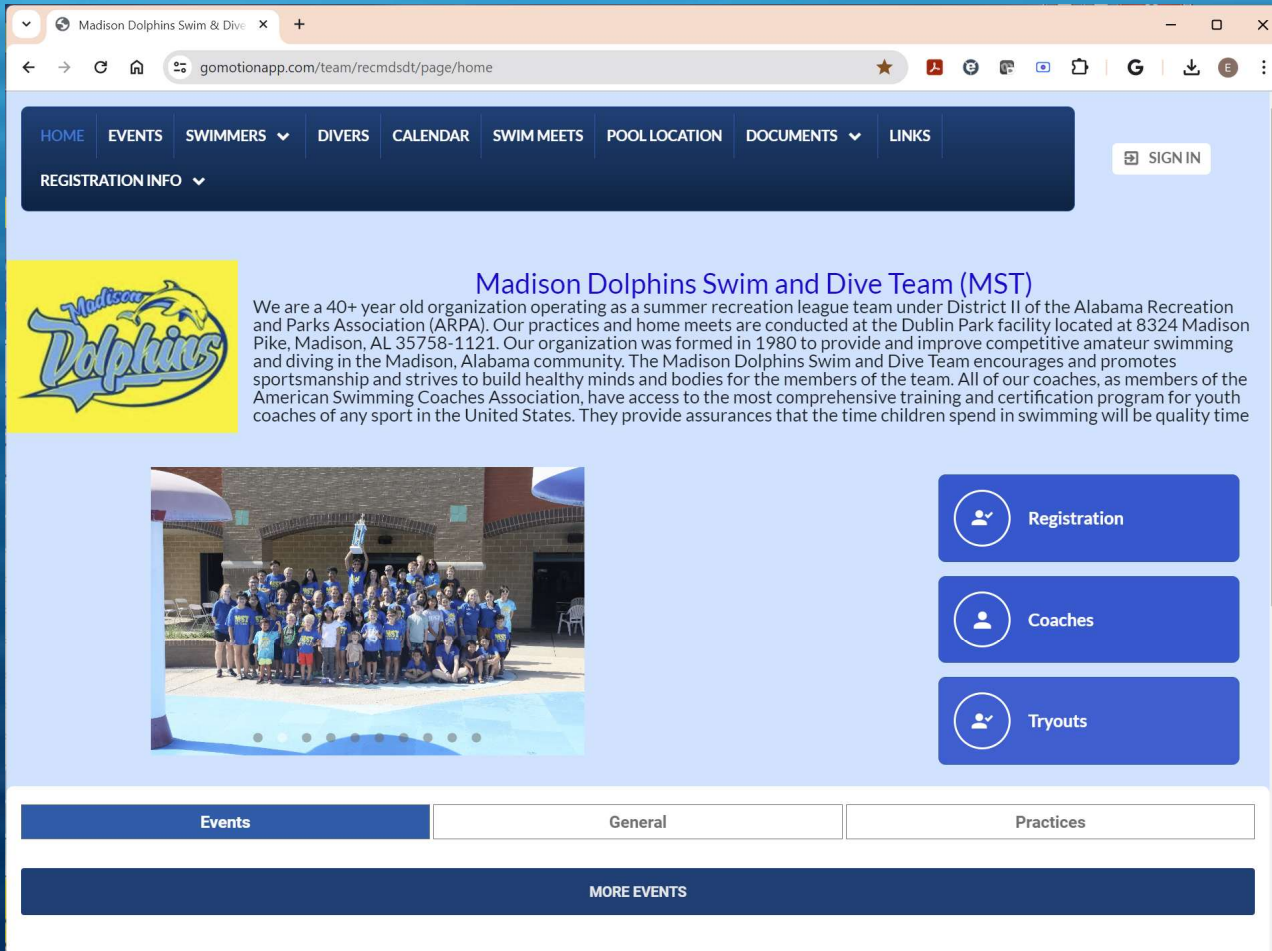

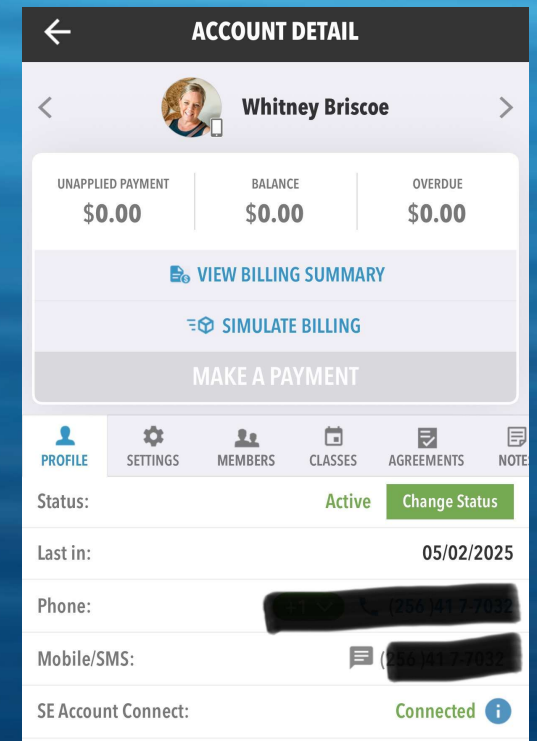

How to signup Event jobs:

Step 1: Find the empty slots shown as "-----".

Step 2: Click on the checkbox in front of the empty slot that you want to sign up for.

Step 3: Select [Signup] button to signup for the slots that you selected.

Note: If your Account name is printed right after the checkbox, you've signed up for that job. You do NOT have to "Signup" again. You, however, can use the "Remove Signup" button to remove the signup if you no longer want to work on that job.

If someone else's name is printed, that job slot is not available for you to sign up (this is a first-come-first-serve system). You can only sign up for the empty slots shown as "-----".
