Practice sign-in

- Dublin requires that all swimmers sign-in for every practice
 - "Practice Sign-in Book" located at the front desk at both indoor and outdoor pools.
 - Find your name and place a check mark on the day/date.

Meet sign-up

7 Dual Meets

- Must indicate availability in "Meet Sign-up Book" located on the indoor pool deck.
- Online Sign up, this closes 48 hours before the meet. Use Meet sign up book after online sign-up closes.

Medal Meet

- Choose 5 Events (see website for events)
- \$5.00/event + \$5 surcharge
- Online Meet Entry Deadline Sunday the 11th of June

Districts

- Choose 3 Individual Events, Meet Fees Included in registration.
- Indicate availability for Relays
- Online Meet Entry Deadline Monday the 26th of June



Blue-Gold Meet

- FRIDAY the 26th of May, warmups start 3:30 pm
- Dolphins only time trial meet, <u>everybody swims</u>.
- Indicate online if "Attending" or "Not-Attending".
 - Everybody swims every event, if possible.
- Team pictures of each age group will be taken before warmups.



Swimmer Eligibility

State ARPA Rules: ARTICLE I – Eligibility

- A swimmer or diver cannot compete on two (2) swim teams at the same time during ARPA swimming season.
- A swimmer or diver may compete in ARPA Competition and U.S. Swimming Open Competition if the swimmer is independently registered with U.S. Swimming and is swimming in U.S. Swimming Open Competition unattached. Important for Long Course Swimmers.

District 2 Rules: Rule IV-3 Eligibility

• Individual swimmers must participate in a minimum of three (3) District 2 swim meets to qualify for the District 2 Championships.



State Meet Order of Events

State Qualifying Time (SQT) – See website for times

- Top 16 swimmers with SQT advance to State, including 6&U
- Top 4 regardless of time advance to State
- 9 Relays per age group advance from District 2



Swimmer Conduct

- Good behavior is expected of swimmers at all times, especially when practicing with the team, using facilities, equipment, and representing the team at a meet.
- Previous issues with poor behavior in and damage to the boys bathrooms at Dublin.

 Dublin Park and Rec will make the bathrooms offlimits without parent supervision if it continues.

Volunteer Requirements

- Team families will be required to work a minimum:
 - Medal Meet.
 - 5 Dual Meets.
- Development families
 - Medal Meet
 - 3 Home Dual Meets
- Requirements do not apply to Diving Only parents, but you will need to work the District Dive meet, and any other home meet.



- Sign ups will be through Team Unify.
 - Use the Website or On-Deck App
- Use the login you have for registration.
- Select the meet, job and session you wish to sign up for.



Volunteering Incentive

- Lack of volunteers
 - Cause delay in meets starting on time.
 - Require some parents to volunteer more sessions than required.
- Track participation by family.
- For those who don't complete the requirements a fee of \$100 will be added to your account
- The Team needs everyone to do their fair share.
 - Let's be the example.



- Please report promptly to your selected job.
 - Meets can't start until everybody is in place
- A sign-in sheet at each meet will log your participation.
- If you can't make a meet you signed up for, let us know as soon as possible so a replacement can be found.


