- Facilities:** Located on the campus of University of Memphis, the Student Recreation and Sports Complex houses an indoor 50-meter by 25-yard Myrtha Competition Pool, multi-course configurations, Colorado Gen7 Time System, Colorado Aquagrip touchpads, two Full Matrix LED Scoreboards, Hy-Tek Meet Manager and a consistent depth of 7 feet. Continuous warm-up and warm-down is available in four 25-yard lanes. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.
- Meet Format:** All events will be conducted in short course yards as timed finals. All events will be pre-seeded. Final lane configurations will be determined following receipt of all meet entries. USA Swimming rules govern MSSL City Meet Championship.
- Eligibility:** All participants must be registered members of the Memphis Summer Swim League and have a signed MSSL waiver and release on file with their team before participating in this meet.
- The competitor's age and division are determined by their age as of June 1, 2025.
- Swimmers must have participated in at least 1 regular season dual meet.
- All teams must be registered, league dues paid, entries submitted via email and entry fees paid by the appropriate deadlines in order to participate.
- If a swimmer misses his or her event due to negligence on the part of the swimmer or coach, there will be no attempt at accommodation. If a swimmer misses a race due to interference from meet personnel, accommodations will be made to swim the event later if possible.
- There are no substitutions for absent swimmers.
- Once the psych sheet is posted, coaches may only add a new swimmer to the meet or remove a swimmer from the meet. No event additions/changes will be accepted.
- Coaches:** Only summer league coaches may perform coaching duties and have access to areas restricted for swimmers, coaches and officials.
- Entries:** Swimmers are limited to four (4) individual events, two (2) relays in their own age group and one (1) relay in next older age group.

Only e-mailed entries will be accepted. Entry times should be best times in SCY.

A swimmer must swim in at least one individual event in order to swim on a relay team.

Each relay team must have at least 3 swimmers from that age group. The intent is to allow all swimmers to compete in a relay, not to create more relay teams.

Relay entries without names of the individual swimmers will not be accepted and the relay will be scratched.

If your team can complete a relay team with age-appropriate swimmers, this must be done. For example, if a club has twelve 9-10 boys participating, they must create 3 relay teams. The team cannot create 4 relay teams by moving one swimmer up for each team.

No coed relays are allowed.

Entry Deadline: Entries must be received via EMAIL by 5:00pm on July 6th.

Entry Updates: A deadline for coaches to update entries will be announced when the psych sheet goes out.

Late Entries: No late entries will be accepted after the entry update deadline.

Deck Entries: No deck entries will be accepted.

Warm-Up: Warm-up lanes will be ASSIGNED based on team size.

Schedule: All age groups will compete in the same session.

Warm-Ups	Competition

Reporting: 10&under swimmers in all events will report to the bullpen. 11&Over swimmers in all events will report directly to the starting blocks.

Scratches: USA Swimming scratch rules for timed finals will be in effect. No swimmer may scratch from an entered event and then enter another event. No swimmer may enter a later event to make up for a missed event.

Scoring: Points for 1st through 16th place in individual events will be awarded

Scoring per team is limited to the top 2 places in each individual event and relays.

There are no team divisions for this meet.

Individual events are scored: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1.

Relays are scored: 40-34-32-30-28-26-24-22-18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2.

Separate male and female events scored as: 6&under, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15&Over.

Awards: Awards will be managed and distributed by MSSSL.

Individual Awards:	Medals will be awarded for 1st through 6th place and ribbons will be awarded for 7th-16th. place in all events. High point trophies will be awarded to the top 10 individuals in each age and gender category in this manner: High Point, 1st Runner-up, 2nd Runner-up, 3rd Runner-up, 4th Runner-up, 5th Runner-up, 6 th Runner-up, 7 th Runner-up, 8 th Runner-up and 9 th Runner-up.
Team Awards:	Team points will be awarded for places 1-16. In each event only the top 2 swimmers and top relay per team will be scored regardless of their seed time. Team Awards will be given to the top three teams. The Award Ceremonies will take place at the end of the meet.
Heat Sheets:	Heat sheets will be provided for free and posted on the Memphis Tiger Swimming site for printing. Heat sheets will not be sold or handed out at the meet.
Results:	Real time results will be available on Meet Mobile app.
Team Areas:	Teams may utilize the bleachers on deck at the east end or the gymnasium for their team area.
Volunteers:	2 nd half volunteers will report in after the PARENT relay
Spectators:	The upstairs stands are reserved for patrons and spectators only. Marshals will be patrolling the stands to make sure swimmers are not sitting upstairs. Please help us to keep the hallways clear, no one is allowed to sit in the hallways of the facility.
Disabilities:	Coaches with a physically or mentally challenged swimmer must contact Meet Referee before entry deadline to ensure that any special needs of the swimmer can be accommodated.
Amenities:	Hospitality provided for coaches, officials and MSSL League Reps only. Concessions will be available in the lobby. Lifeguards will be on duty and a first aid station will be available.
Coaches Meeting:	A coaches meeting may be held after warm-ups before the start of the session. No swimmers will be allowed in the pool at this time.
Broadcast Rights:	Any photographs, videotape or other audio and/or visual recordings of the event created by a spectator may be used solely for such spectator's personal non-commercial use, and may not be broadcast, published or disseminated, or used for any commercial purposes, without the prior written consent of Memphis Tiger Swimming.
Image Authorization:	All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the official photographer(s) and network(s) of Memphis Tiger Swimming under the conditions authored by Memphis Tiger Swimming, and allow event organizers the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during or after the period of participation in Memphis Tiger Swimming competitions for promotion, marketing and publicity purposes.
