

# Evansville Winter Kickstarter September 27 - 28, 2025

**SANCTION:** This meet is sanctioned by USA Swimming and Indiana Swimming. Sanction #IN26011

FACILITIES: C

Competition Pool: 65 meter by 25 yard pool. Competition non-turbulent land markers with take off platforms. Depth of the racing course at the start is a minimum of 7 feet with Colorado timing system. Meet will be conducted in lanes 1-10 with additional lanes available for warm-up and warm-down. Seating for approximately 800 spectators, completely handicapped accessible. There is no smoking allowed in the competition venue.

The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with the Deaconess Aquatic Center.

**RULES:** 

Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), will govern this meet.

USA Swimming Rules 202.5.3 - At a sanctioned competitive event, USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist in making arrangements for such supervision, but it is the swimmer's responsibility to make such arrangements prior to the start of the meet.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming-member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Coaches and Officials MUST display their current USA Swimming coach credential or Deck Pass to gain deck access. The meet referee and/or meet director reserves the right to ask for coach credential or Deck Pass and/or deny deck access if coach does not comply or card is no longer valid/current.

Deck changes are prohibited.

In swimming competitions, the competitor must wear only one swimsuit in one or two pieces except as provided in 205.10.1. All swimsuits shall be made from textile materials. For men, the swimsuit shall not extend above the navel nor below the knees, and for women, shall not cover the neck, extend past the shoulder, nor extend below the knee.

RULES CONTINUED:

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.



**202.4.9** J: Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair.

The Head Referee reserves the right to use fly-over starts, if it is deemed necessary.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Swimmer(s) must be registered with USA Swimming prior to the competition.

Age as of September 27, 2025 shall determine the swimmer's age for the entire meet.

Indiana Swimming does not process on-site athlete registration.

**ENTRIES:** Teams are to submit entries to Jennifer Brown via email at GMSA.entries@gmail.com.

The use of a HYTEK entry file (.CL2 file extension) is strongly encouraged. All times must be submitted in short course yards and to the hundredth of a second. Converted

times must use HYTEK Time Converter.

**DECK ENTRIES:** Deck entries for individual events will be accepted up until 30 minutes before the start of

the session. Deck entries will only be accepted provided there is a lane available and only as a new addition. No additional heats will be created to accommodate deck entries. No deck entries will be permitted for events that have been limited. Deck entries will be entered as NT (no time), and the event will not be reseeded. Entry fee for deck entries is

\$10.00 per event.

**LIMITS:** Swimmers may enter in no more than four (4) individual events per day. If an entry is

submitted with an individual entered in more events than this rule allows, the entry will be made by order of events starting with Event #1 until the rule is satisfied; there will be no

refunds for individuals over-entered in events.

The host reserves the right of sole discretion to determine which entries are accepted. In exercising this discretion, the host may consider the number of officials provided by

the team, balance of age groups and gender entries, level of competition, and

geographic location.

FEES:

The host reserves the right to modify heats and/or events in order to facilitate the

timeline of the meet. The host also reserves the right to limit the number of

competitors in <u>any</u> event in order to run the meet in the allotted time. Entry fees of any

canceled heats / swims will be refunded.

All fees must be paid no later than one hour prior to the start of the first session of the competition. Please make checks payable to GOLD MEDAL SWIM ACADEMY. The

Release and Hold Harmless Agreement must also be submitted with payment or

electronically before your team / athlete is permitted to compete.

All Individual Entries \$5.00

Deck Entries \$10.00

Surcharge (Per Athlete) \$15.00

#### MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO "GOLD MEDAL SWIM ACADEMY"

**DEADLINES:** We will begin taking entries on Monday August 25, 2025. We will continue to receive

entries and updates until 5:00 P.M. on Friday, September 19, 2025 or until the meet is full. You will be notified as soon as possible if the meet fills and your entries are not accepted.

Entered teams are able to update their entries until the registration deadline.

**MEET FORMAT:** This meet will be conducted in a timed finals format for all swimmers.



POSITIVE CHECK-IN:

The 400Y IM will be positive check-in and will be swum slow to fast. All other events

will be pre-seeded.

CLERK OF COURSE:

There will be a clerk of course for all 8 & Under events. All other swimmers are

responsible for being behind the blocks at the appropriate time.

**AWARDS:** No ribbons or medals will be awarded for individual event winners. High point trophies

will be awarded point scorers of each gender in each age group.

Heat awards will be given to all heat winners. Awards will not be mailed.

**SCORING:** Sixteen places (16) will be scored for individual events. Points will be awarded as follows:

Individual Events: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1

8 & Under Events: will be scored as 8 & Under

9 - 10 Events: will be scored as 9 - 10

11 - 12 Events: will be scored as 11-12

13 & Over Events: will be scored as 13 & Over

Open Events: will be scored as Open

**RESULTS:** Results files will be available at the end of the meet.

**SPECTATOR INFO:** All parents must remain in the viewing area. No parents allowed on deck without

permission.

Admission will be free

<u>Heat sheets</u> will be posted throughout the facility & pool deck. We will also provide heat sheets digitally via Meet Mobile and will send a PDF to each coaching staff at least 24 hours prior to the start of the competition.

**CONCESSIONS:** A variety of concessions will be provided.
