



Parent Commitment

1. I will read and understand the Handbook.
2. I will ensure my swimmer(s) arrives to practice on time.
3. I will ensure my swimmer(s) is well rested, hydrated, and properly nourished at meets and practices.
4. I will declare my swimmer(s) as “In” or “Out” for each meet of the season as required by the coaching staff.
5. I will set an example of good sportsmanship through positive behavior and communication.
6. I will stay off the pool deck during practices.
7. I will not bring pets to practice nor meets nor championships.
8. I will use appropriate procedure to resolve conflicts.
9. I agree to the VOLUNTEER AND FUNDRAISING COMMITTEMENT REQUIREMENT as set forth for each season.
10. I will aim to commit my swimmer’s attendance in at least 2 league meets a season.

Conflict Resolution Procedure

When a conflict arises between parents and coaches, email is the best way to communicate any concerns you may have. If you prefer to meet in person, a board member must also be present and the following steps should be taken:

1. Avoid discussing the issue with other parents or coaches on deck.
2. Schedule a specific time to meet with a coach via email with a reason for the
3. Meeting.
4. Be prepared with specific concerns and suggestions to resolve the issue.
