| New Business                | Rio Del Oro Bylaw Violation – Steffi Jones  Rio Del Oro (RDO) swam against Rocklin on 5/20/17 and allowed 31 swimmers to swim unregistered violating sections 3.04 and 11.03d of the NCSL bylaws  When Section 11.03d is applied, 31 swimmers will be scratched from the RDO/Rocklin meet, the swimmers times will not count, the swimmers will not score any points and the times will not be counted towards the 2-meet minimum to participate in 2017 Champs  Discussion on whether RDO should have a hearing (similar to Carmichael's 2016 hearing); motion to vote on whether RDO should be subject to a hearing; 3 in favor, 15 against, 4 abstain Johnson Ranch Exception – Kathy Meyers  John Marks broke wrist and will not meet the 2-meet minimum participation in dual meets; requesting exception to this rule; motion to approve exception to 2-meet minimum; unanimously approved Sunrise Exception – Jeff Petersen  Sally Richter, Madison Prahar, and Atousa Nariman-Hassanabadi requesting to wear additional layer for modesty  Discussion on appropriateness of wearing wet suit vs. woven fabric (wet suit provides some buoyancy)  Motion to approve exception to allow Richter, Prahar and Nariman-Hassanabadi to wear additional layer for modesty as long as the layers of made of woven fabric; unanimously approved  Glen Oaks Exception – Randy Olson  Max Bigelow and Sean Miller met with the STAS swim coach but did not practice with the team; requesting an exception to allow Bigelow and Miller to swim with Glen Oaks; unanimously approved  Rio Linda Exception – Alissia DeSalles  League rep is unsure what the exception is for; will have to go back to the team to get more information  SacTown Exception – Kevin Williams  Ava Sampson requesting to wear jammers for modesty reasons; motion to approve to allow Sampson to wear jammers for modesty reasons; unanimously approved |
