RESOLVED THAT, the Board hereby adopts the Carmichael Beavers Northern California Swim League Swimmer Registration Compliance Plan attached hereto as EXHIBIT A-1.

Carmichael Beavers Northern California Swim League Swimmer Registration Compliance Plan

(Adopted by the Board of Directors on October 11, 2016)

Background

During the 2016 swim season the Beavers violated the NorCal bylaws requirement to have all swimmers registered with NorCal at least 24 hours prior to a meet. The Beaver Board desires to adopt a compliance plan to ensure that similar violations do not occur in the future.

Compliance Plan

- Early Registration. Mandatory online NorCal registration at same time as Beaver registration (laptops/iPads/cell phones).
- 2. Follow-up on Norcal Registration report. Beaver Registrar will follow up on League Report vs. Beaver enrollment and will follow-up with any missing league registrations. President to confirm Registrar has followed up on League report prior to start of April practices.
- 3. No Swim Rule. Board members will be on deck at all practices and will confirm swimmer league registration. Swimmers who are not registered will not be permitted to swim until registered. Swimmers will be allowed to swim if swimmer family can provide proof of NorCal registration.
- 4. Audit prior to Time Trials. One week prior to Time Trials, the team Registrar will audit the Team registration against League registration which shall be verified by the League Representative. The Registrar will follow-up with any missing League registrations. Swimmers who

are not registered with the league will not be allowed to swim at Time Trials.

- 5. Audit prior to first swim meet. The steps in number 4 above shall be implemented prior to the first meet.
- 6. Ban on swimmers in violation of 24-hour rule. The Registrar shall notify the President, League Representative and Head Coach by noon the day prior to the meet. Swimmers not registered in compliance with the 24-hour rule will not be able to swim at that meet.
- 7. Ban on swimmers in violation of any other League bylaws. If the League has any other swimmer registration regulations (i.e. a June 15th cutoff date) the procedure in number 4 shall be applied to any such rule. Swimmers in violation of these rules will not be allowed to swim at any meet that they are ineligible to swim under League rules.
- 8. Responsibility for Compliance Plan. The team President shall be responsible to ensure that the Team is in compliance of the Compliance Plan at all times.
- 9. Communication of Compliance Plan. A copy of this plan, as updated by the Board from time to time, will be included in the Team Parent Handbook, posted on Team Website and included in swimmer registration packets.

Carmichael Beaver Statement regarding swimmer registration Infraction and Compliance Plan

Background

During the Beaver's first meet of the year last season, the Beavers were at Folsom in a non-conference meet. At that time, the Beavers were rebuilding their swimmer enrollment base and at least half of our swimmers were new to the team. At that time our Board believed that all of our swimmers needed to be registered with the league by June 15th. We were not aware of the league's position that all swimmers had to be registered 24 hours prior to swimming in any meet until Steffi called Thad the Friday before our Folsom meet. Prior to the Folsom meet we registered all of our swimmers with the league who would be swimming in the Folsom meet. We understand now, that we were in violation of the 24-hour advance registration requirement. We did not realize at that time that the 24-hour requirement was important to the league and intended to be strictly enforced. We apologize for committing this technical infraction. We did not want to disappoint our new swimmers who were looking forward to their first meet and who would be critical to growing our membership base and we thought that as long as they were registered prior to the meet we would be at least within the spirit of the rule.

Compliance Plan

At our August 9th Carmichael Beaver Board meeting, the Board passed a resolution requiring all swimmers be registered with the league before May 1st. We intend to implement this resolution by the following methods:

- 1. Computer/tablets at all of our public registration events;
- 2. Computer/tablets available at swim practice;
- 3. Our registrar and League rep will monitor our enrollment list to our league registration list and will be responsible for following up with swimmer families who are not registered with the league; and
- 4. Implement a policy of not allowing swimmers to swim at practices until their league registration is complete.

Closing Remarks

On behalf of the Beaver Board and our President, Shelly Eyraud, we again are sorry for the amount of time that this has taken for the league's Board and Officers. We hope that our compliance plan will allow us to be compliant with the league's registration requirements on a go forward basis. If the League Board and or its officers have any further questions for the Beavers related to this issue, Shelly has asked that those questions be sent to her by email so that she can respond to them. I regret that I am not in a position to engage in a question and answer session at this time. Thanks you for the opportunity to explain what happened and how we are seeking to fix it in the future. We believe we are a good fit for the league and we hope to prove ourselves as an upstanding member of the league for years to come.

New ByLaw:

Addition to EXHIBIT B

XI. Observed Swims

Conferences, at their discretion, and by majority vote of conference Teams, may choose to have their championship meet observed by assigned USA Swimming officials pursuant with USS Rule 202.7 as it pertains to the meet being a season-culminating Championship. Official times achieved as observed swims may be submitted into the SWIMS database if conditions outlined in USS Rule 202.7 are met. The conference teams are responsible for following the process outlined in USS Rule 202.7.
