Guy Garcia proposed that the league will sponsor the team that does computer operations this year with \$500 to buy a printer versus renting a copy machine for champs. The team that will accept the \$500 will be responsible for the additional cost and will provide the champs with that printer in the following 2 years. Motion was made to approve a shift from renting copier to giving a grant for the purchase of a printer in the amount of \$500 to the team that will run the computer operations at this year's championship. B) Tech swimsuit clarification and NCSL suit policy: After some discussion it was decided that our league will stick to the established rule from 2009 that will allow only team suits or suits similar to the team suit but no technical suit.
