






Location

Foothill High School 5000 McCloud Dr, Sacramento, CA 95842

Parking

- Reserved Lot (nearest pool): Champs or accessible permits only. No permit? Expect to move or be towed
- **General Parking:** Surrounding lots and neighborhood areas. Respect signage and driveways
- **No Unloading Zone:** Unless assisting someone with a physical impairment—park first, then unload









Pool Information

- 10-lane competition pool with Time Drops timing system
- Warm-up/ Warm Down lanes (2 lanes monitored by volunteers (NOT for play)
- Cooling room available during extreme heat



A Deck & Spectator Guidelines

- Bleachers available during swimmer's race—no camping out please return to team area after your swimmer's race to ensure viewing space for other spectators
- Deck access restricted to volunteers during assigned shifts
- Access to restricted deck areas requires deck pass or volunteer sticker
- Deck marshals monitor entrances—be courteous
- Return to team area after shift







A Team Areas

- Preassigned locations—camp only in your designated space
- Keep pathways clear at all times

Officiating

Meet Referee: Andrew Mock (Rio Del Oro)

- USA Swimming Certified for Stroke and Turn
- Enforces NCSL rules fairly and consistently
- Ensure swimmer eligibility, suit compliance, and race integrity
- Suit Policy: Team swimsuits and all FINA-stamped suits are acceptable.
 Unstamped tech suits must be approved by Meet Referee before use. Bring suit for to Meet Referee for approval—not worn prior to meet.

Volunteering

- Check in with team volunteer coordinator before your shift
- Wear volunteer sticker to access the deck
- Volunteers must be "tagged out" before leaving
- Arrive on time—honor your commitment to fellow volunteers

Ready Bench Procedures

- ALL swimmers (including relays) must use Ready Bench
 - 13-18 year old swimmers must check in at the ready bench prior to reporting to the blocks
- NO parents or siblings allowed in the ready bench area
- Cell phones must be left in tents
- Mark arm for faster processing:
 - Saturday: RIGHT forearm, Right Shoulder
 - o **Sunday:** LEFT forearm, Left Shoulder
 - o Format:
 - Name on shoulder with age group
 - SMITH, J 9/10
 - Event/Heat/Name on Forearm
 - 12/2/3 (event/heat/lane)
- Official team parents and Ready Bench volunteers only permitted in area
- Ready Bench Volunteers will escort swimmers to correct lanes







Warm-Up Lane Rules

- No diving, flipping, rope hanging, or swimming across lanes
- Feet-first entry only
- Only team-registered swimmers (Rio, Laguna Creek, Gold River and Del Norte) allowed

Meet Format & Finals

Meet Schedule Overview:

- Final meet program (including timeline and psych sheet) will be available Friday,
 July 25
- Meet schedule included with Meet Guide (sent Thursday prior to event)

Saturday:

- 100 IM, Short Free, Backstroke
- Parent Relay during 40-min break
- Finals warm-up & finals races
- 6U Free Relay
- 6U Awards Ceremony
- Medley Relay

Sunday:

- Long Free, Breaststroke, Butterfly
- Coaches Relay during break
- Finals & Freestyle Relays
- Tear Down
- Awards Ceremony (after breakdown)

Finals Info:

- Top 10 swimmers in each event race in Finals
- 2 alternates must report with Meet Referee prior to race
- No-show without prior scratch = removal from all finals that day

Circle Seeding (Top 3 Heats):

- Each heat seeded using submitted times, following NCSL pattern
- Fastest heats appear last in each event





Last 3 preliminary heats for each event are circle seeded.

Event Tracking & Results

Meet Mobile and Time Drops App:

- Search: "2025 Goldrush Champs"
- PIN for Time Drops: 0726
- Shows heat/lane assignments & unofficial results
- Scores posted in real time but subject to DQ verification
- Final results will be printed & posted

Scoreboard Note:

- Scoreboard and Time Drops show unofficial results
- Expect minor variation in posted vs official times

Photography Rules & Social Media

- **Designated Team Photographers Only** allowed on deck
- No photos/videos allowed of swimmers on blocks or during starts
- Imer volunteers must keep phones away during shifts
- Social media use should respect privacy—avoid capturing other children

- Championship Apparel T-shirts available at merchandise tent—accepts cash and card.
- Street Vendors On the black top—selling swim gear (Jolyn -Saturday only), pizza, tacos, snacks, dessert & more.

X What NOT to Bring

- Glass containers
- Pets
- Noise makers (especially during race starts)
- No alcohol
- Valuables (keep them secure or leave them at home!)
