Volunteer Job Descriptions — 2025

Timing Roles

Head Timer

- Oversees lane timers during each shift.
- o Starts backup stopwatch at the beginning of each race.
- Must be experienced in timing procedures.

• Timers (3 per lane, lanes 1–10)

- o Use time drops pendants and stopwatches for accurate race timing.
- o Attend daily timer meeting at 8:00 a.m. on deck.

♦ ♂ Pool Movement Roles

Runner

o Collects DQ slips and timing sheets from each side of the pool.

¥ Volunteer Check-in

• Registration Table Staff

- o One per team for full shift coverage.
- o Checks in volunteers, distributes badges, confirms posts.
- May contact team coordinator if issues arise.

Parking Lot Attendant

- Directs traffic flow and assists with parking near team areas.
- Ensures emergency access lanes remain clear at all times.
- Greets arriving volunteers and spectators, providing basic directions if needed.
- Reports safety concerns, unauthorized parking, or hazards to meet officials.
- Wears high-visibility vest and remains in designated lot zones throughout the shift.

▲ Deck Patrol Roles

Monitors to ensure only authorized individuals are on deck:

Deck Entry Monitor

- o Keeps area clear, including warm-up lanes.
- o Clears unauthorized persons.
- Supervises entry via deck gate.
- o Observes for hazards, refers public pool inquiries to lifeguards.

Warm Up Lane Monitor

o Supervises lanes for swimmers

o Ensures swimmer warm-up activity only—NO play or loitering.

Deck Access Rules

✓ Allowed on deck:

- Swimmers escorted by ready bench
- Coaches with deck passes
- Stroke & Turn Judges with uniform shirts and badges
- Volunteers with proper badges/lanyards
- Deck roles: runners, clerks, timers, announcers, etc.
- Deck Patrol monitors and gate monitors

Not allowed on deck:

- Parents of swimmers (except exceptions noted above)
- Spectators, young children not swimming
- Swimmers not actively racing or waiting

🔒 Ready Bench Team

- Lead
 - o Organizes ready bench volunteers and ensures swimmer flow.
 - Supports lead with same duties.
- Co Lead
 - o Begins filtering swimmers, monitors and checks names.
- Support Runner (2 per shift)
 - o Escorts swimmers to blocks in order.
- Support (2 per shift)
 - o Flexible role depending on needs.
- Ready Bench Entry Monitor
 - Ensures only swimmers and approved escorts pass through entry to ready bench area and competition pool.

M Hospitality Crew

- Plan menu and rollout schedule.
- o Food prep and assembly.
- Delivers goods to timers, Stroke & Turn judges, coaches, officials, ready bench crew, warm-up lane monitors, deck patrol.

Clerk of the Course

- One clerk of the course oversees lanes 1-10
- o Positioned behind blocks, verify swimmers for each race.
- o Confirm lineup and give "thumbs up" to starter.
