Six-lane, 25-meter pool

Meet Format and Focus:

This is an exhibition All-Star style meet with the sole purpose being geared toward a **FUN** 

event for all teams involved.

Each swim team will be randomly assigned a lane that they will start the meet from and then teams will rotate one spot to the left with each successive heat, with the team in lane

6 moving back to lane 1.

There will be 1 heat per event and each team can enter only one swimmer in each individual

event and 1 team into each relay event.

**Schedule:** Warm up sessions will begin at 7:35 AM with 2 teams warming up at a time (see schedule

below). A Coaches meeting will be held at 7:45 AM and lane assignments will be drawn. An Officials meeting will be held at 7:50 AM and a Timers meeting will be held at 8:00 AM.

The pool will be cleared at 8:20 AM for the meet to begin by 8:30 AM.

**Awards:** Medals will be awarded for 1st through 3rd place in each event and given to the swimmers

on the podium during designated awards breaks. A trophy will also be awarded to the team

that accumulates the most points.

Eligibility: All registered PWSL swimmers who are members of the invited teams. NOTE: This event is

intended for six teams, but if there is enough interest, twelve teams may be considered.

**Rules:** Current PWSL Swimming rules will govern this meet.

Officials and

**Volunteers:** 

Each participating team is required to provide 1 stroke & turn judge. Head Referees and Starters will also be required and will be determined by the Meet Director. Other volunteer requirements will be outlined in the pre-meet informational package that will be sent out

only to the participating teams.

Participation: Please confirm your intent to participate or decline as early as possible so we have time to

invite alternate teams as necessary. Teams that have participated in previous years will

have priority; otherwise it will be first come, first served.

If your team has not confirmed that they will be participating in this event by 6:00 PM **Friday, June 2nd**, we will assume you have declined and we will proceed with finding

replacements as needed.

Entries: Team entries are due no later than Sunday, June 25th at 8:00 PM. Our computer rep will

provide a meet file to each team by Sunday, June 17<sup>th</sup> with instructions for entering your primary swimmers. An alternate swimmer will be required for each event and they should be entered into the corresponding alternate event in the file per instructions. The alternate

can only be used in the event of injury or illness to a competing swimmer.

Substitution Policy:

Substitutions are only permitted if these 2 conditions exist, 1) an injury or illness prevents a swimmer from competing and 2) the alternate has already been used. If these conditions exist, a team may replace a swimmer with someone who has a slower time than the person originally entered.

Substitutions must be turned in to the Meet Referee by 8:00 AM on the morning of the meet. A substitution form will be handed out to the coaches when they arrive at the pool for warmups

**Entry Limits:** 

There will be only one heat per event. Each team is permitted to bring one individual swimmer per event. These swimmers will also be used to form a medley relay team in each age group. There must be 4 individual swimmers in each relay with the exception of the crescendo relay. Each individual swimmer is allowed to swim in only 1 individual event but may swim in both relays.

The medley relay will be made up of the swimmers entered into each of the individual events. Each prescribed stroke of the relay will be completed by the same swimmer who was entered in that individual event (i.e., the swimmer entered in the individual freestyle must swim the freestyle leg of the relay).

The crescendo event will be made up from any of the swimmers entered into the meet regardless of the individual event they were entered in and shall consist of 1 swimmer from each age group (8 & under, 9-10, 11-12,13-14, and 15-18). As part of the crescendo relay the 8 & under & 9-10 will swim 25 meters with the remaining age group swimmers completing 50 meters, for a total distance of 200 meters.

**Entry Fees:** 

There is no fee required to enter this meet, however, the Bridlewaves request that everyone bring some canned or dried goods items that can be donated to the Food Bank at SERVE in Manassas. Here are the current items on their want list:

Canned vegetables, pasta and spaghetti, pasta sauce, canned meats, canned tomatoes and tomato sauce, cereal, canned fruit, cleaning supplies, toilet paper and paper towels

Food:

Our concessions will be open featuring a limited breakfast, snacks and drinks menu. The BWaves concessions accepts CASH ONLY.

T-Shirt:

A 2023 Stars and Stripes Invitational T-shirt will be given to each swimmer entered in the meet courtesy of our sponsors. Each team will receive 42 tee shirts in representative sizes (erring on the side of a size up) -40 tees for swimmers plus 2 tees for coaches.

Additional shirts are available for pre-order at the cost of \$15 each (2XL/3XL - \$17 each). Sizes for additional shirts must be submitted no later than 12:00pm on Sunday, June 25<sup>th</sup>.

Parking:

There is a small parking lot at the pool that fills up quickly. Spots are first come, first served. The pool parking lot includes three reserved handicapped spots. There is plenty of parking at ImagiNation and surrounding streets.

Scoring:

The Stars and Stripes Invitational meet is comprised of 52 events: 12 relays and 40 individual events. Swimmers earn points for their teams by competing in their individual and relay events. Barring a disqualification or lack of swimmer participating, each team will earn points in every event as designated in the tables below.

The team with the most points wins the meet.



#### **Pool Layout and Coaches Areas:**



**NOTES:** The BWaves will provide a coaching tent and "bench seating" for each team along the deck. Teams are encouraged to bring no more than four 8x8 tents for their team area (grassy area) as indicated on the pool layout above. Spectators will **only** be allowed in the areas indicated in white and this event is "standing room only" – NO CHAIRS OR TENTS WILL BE PERMITTED ON DECK. (If your team has a need for a handicap viewing area, please let us know ahead of time). The area on the far end of the pool (by the medal stand), will be closed off to spectators during the 25m events and the relays, to accommodate swimmers and/or timers.

#### **Team Areas:**

<u>UPDATE:</u> We have been informed by our HOA that we are not allowed to set up tents on the basketball or tennis courts as we have in past years. This is to prevent undue wear and tear as the courts have recently been resurfaced. As such, we will have a combined tent area in the grassy areas surrounding the pool.

Parents – we will have speakers facing out towards the tent areas and make frequent announcements for events and awards presentations. However, based on past experience – because the event moves along quickly – you may consider leaving your tents at home or tent-sharing with friends to be closer to the action!

#### **Volunteer Requirements**

#### **General Information:**

The meet will consist of 1 shift: 8:30am to the end of meet (about 11:30am).

Kingsbrooke is requested to bring their starter system, fully charged, as a backup.

**Announcer:** Bridlewood supplies system and announcer.

**Awards Distributor:** (Compare to the Ribbon Labelers) There will be medals for the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners of each heat. Awards personnel will organize the medals for distribution during the designated awards breaks.

Wellington and Kingsbrooke each supply one (1) awards distributor for a total of two (2).

**Computer:** Bridlewood supplies system and worker, Dominion Valley supplies a computer rep.

**Head Timer:** Victory Lakes and Braemar each supply one (1) head timer, for a total of two (2).

**Lane Assigners:** In lieu of a Clerk of Course each team supplies one (1) lane assigner, for a total of five (5). This person will assist lining up swimmers and direct them to the appropriate lane. Lane assignments will rotate up one lane per event as described in the Meet Announcement.

**Recorders:** Each team supplies one (1) recorder, for a total of five (6) assigned as follows:

Lane 1: Braemar
Lane 2: Wellington
Lane 3: Kingsbrooke
Lane 4: Dominion Valley
Lane 5: Bridlewood
Lane 6: Victory Lakes

**Timers:** Each team supplies three (3) timers, assigned as follows:

Lane 1: Wellington, Dominion Valley, Victory Lakes

Lane 2: Bridlewood, Kingsbrooke, Braemar

Lane 3: Wellington, Dominion Valley, Victory Lakes

Lane 4: Bridlewood, Kingsbrooke, Braemar

Lane 5: Wellington, Dominion Valley, Victory Lakes

Lane 6: Bridlewood, Kingsbrooke, Braemar

**Runners:** Each team supplies one (1) runner for a total of five (6).

#### **Volunteer Requirements**

**Scorers:** Bridlewood, Dominion Valley, and Braemar each supply one (1) scorer for a total of three (3). Note: Scoring is different than a standard meet. The scoring process is described in the meet announcement.

**Verifiers:** Kingsbrooke, Victory Lakes, and Wellington each supply one (1) verifier for a total of three (3).

**Stroke and Turn Judges:** At least one (1) per team – Head Referee and Starters supplied by Bridlewood.

**Water Runner:** Bridlewood supplies one (1) water runner.

**Tee Shirts:** Every swimmer participating in the Stars & Stripes Invitational will receive a commemorative tee shirt. Each team will receive 42 tee shirts (40 for swimmers and 2 for coaches) in a representative range of sizes. Each team should provide one (1) person to collect their team shirts and distribute shirts to the swimmers before the meet. **Extra shirts may be pre-ordered for \$15 each (2XL/3XL are \$17 each)**, but sizes must be sent in by Sunday, June 25<sup>th</sup> at 12:00pm.
