OBB Parents! Safety Reminder

Per USA swimming rules, no video or pictures may be taken behind the starting "blocks."

This applies to the starting line for both individual races and relays (which sometimes have a start on the "turn" end of the pool). If you are timing or recording, you are operating in an official capacity for the team and can not be videoing or taking pictures. If you would like to record video or take pictures, you must stand in the spectator viewing area.



Order Divisionals Spirit Wear!

The 2024 Black Division tri-meet is Saturday, July 27 at the Ridgewood Pool. Swimmers must have officially competed in two (2) dual meets this season to participate (exhibition swims do NOT count). For individual events, swimmers must have a 2024, legal "seed" time before divisionals to swim that event in the divisionals meet.

Ribbons

Each week, a hardworking group of volunteers works throughout every meet and again for several hours following the competition "writing ribbons" for our swimmers. First through twelfth place ribbons are awarded in each age group.

Each swimmer who drops any amount of time in an individual, legal swim earns a Breakers time improvement ribbon. New swimmers who have yet to place or drop time are awarded a Breakers participation ribbon. Every swimmer who swims in that week's meet will be awarded at least one ribbon. FYI - time improvement ribbons are based on times from this season only.




- The Barracudas' pool is located at 12350 Oakwood Drive, Woodbridge, VA 22192
