Pool Rules & Regulations

General Rules

- Everyone must check in with the lifeguard at the desk upon arrival. Check in each visit.
- Guests must be checked in with a member. All guests must be accompanied by a current Greenwyche member. There is a \$5 guest fee for each in-town guest.
- Out of town guests must also be checked in with a Greenwyche member but are not charged.
- There is also no charge for the following categories of guests: non-swimming visitors who are wearing street clothes, full-time babysitters (16 years or older, who are employed as full time day care providers by a Greenwyche family).
- Members are responsible for the action of their guests.
- Please pick up any food or drink wrappers and place them in the trash immediately after consuming.
- Profanity will not be tolerated on Club property.
- No smoking or vaping within the pool grounds or tennis courts.
- All babies/toddlers who are not potty trained must wear swim diapers.
- Bikes, scooters, skateboards, etc., should be left outside of the pool area and not allowed on deck.
- Please check the lost and found regularly.
- Alcoholic Beverages are prohibited.

Safety Rules

- Lifeguard orders must and shall be always obeyed.
- Please do not have an involved conversation with a guard on stand.
- Smoking and glass are not allowed on the pool deck.
- No running on the deck.
- Use the water slide 1 person at a time, sliding down on your bottom. Make sure the swimmer is to the side before the next swimmer slides down.
- No sitting, standing or climbing on pool rails or lane ropes.
- There will be a 10-minute rest break for children under the age of 16 before every hour. No one under the age of 16 will be allowed in the pool at this time.
- No swimming in the diving well area when diving boards are in use.
- When diving, swim to the closest side of the pool immediately to exit water.
- No diving toward pool sides; jump straight off of the boards.
- No child over the age of 6 should be in the baby pool at any time.
- No lifeguards are on duty in the baby pool and splash pad area; adult supervision required by parent or guardian of swimmer using the pool/pad.
- If lightning is in the area the pool will be closed for 30 minutes from last lightning sighting.
