TIME TRIALS (AKA, THE DONUT MEET) - May 20

ALL swimmers should plan on attending our *Time Trials meet on Saturday, May 20*. Times earned at Time Trials (aka the Donut Meet, because every swimmer gets a donut after their first swim) will be used to seed our swimmers and set relays at our first dual meet, and will also give each swimmer a starting point for personal best swims this season. We will not offer an alternative date, so if your swimmer is unable to make it, they will enter the first dual meet with a 'No Time' (NT).

- register your swimmer.
- purchase spirit shirts.
- see your volunteer shifts.
- sign-up your athlete for swim meets.

Please note: You must use the same email your family used for registration to log-in to Team Unity (TU). TU only supports one login email address per family.

<u>Mobile APP</u>: TeamUnify provides a FREE and simple-to-use mobile app called **OnDeck**, available in the App Store and on Google Play.
