4th Annual Cardboard Boat Regatta - Saturday, June 17!

We are thrilled to host our 4th Annual Cardboard Boat Regatta on Saturday, June 17! All Sea Otters are encouraged to team up with their swim team friends to construct a sea-worthy vessel using only cardboard and duct tape. Parents, we kindly ask that you support your swimmers by offering guidance and help troubleshooting while they ship build, but allow the kids the opportunity to build, learn and be creative with their Sea Otter friends.

Important Info:

- Boats will be raced in the pool. Each heat will be 50 yards (two lengths of the pool). Depending on the number of entries, your boat may have to survive multiple heats.
- Boats must be human-powered. There is no limit to the number of crew members on each boat.
- Materials allowed:
 - Cardboard or paper (no plastic, waxed cardboard, or waterproof cardboard)
 - Duct tape, or any type of packaging tape
 - Adhesive products such as Liquid Nails for gluing the boat together
 - o Paddles are allowed, but must also be made out of cardboard and duct tape
- Be creative! Run with a theme! Go all out!
- Need ideas on how to build? You can find lots of how to videos online!
