SPIRIT WEEK IS HERE!!! Dress according to our daily themes, and stay after practice for a fun game!



- LOCATION: Independence High School Pool, 617 N. Jackson Avenue, San Jose, CA 95133
- **PARKING**: Parking gates will open at 6:30am. Both school parking lots off of N. Jackson will be open. Street parking on N. Jackson or Mabury is allowed. Do not park in the lot off of Educational Park Drive.
- SEA OTTERS WARM UP SCHEDULE:
  - Meet at the blocks at least 5 minutes prior to your warm up time ready to swim! We will be in lanes 5-10 in the main pool.
    - 7:15-7:28am, 13-18 Yellow & Blue (lanes 5-10)
    - 7:28-7:41am, 11-12 ages (lanes 5-10)
    - 7:41-7:55am
      - 9-10 ages (lanes 5-8)
      - 7-8 ages (lanes 9-10)
    - No warm ups for 6 & under
  - After warm ups, immediately meet at the Sea Otters tent to pick up a special gift for our kids that are swimming at Champs!
  - The diving well is "open warm up" from 7:15–8:30am
- POOL DECK ACCESS: The pool deck will be CLOSED to families. Only swimmers, adults with the correct wristband, Senior swimmer families (for the Senior Swim), and volunteers with pool deck shifts, will be allowed on the pool deck.

- **NO SWIMMER CHECK IN:** Swimmers are NOT required to check-in at CHAMPS. But, if your swimmer ends up sick or not able to attend in the morning of, please immediately contact Edie Fischer at 408-921-0023, so we can manage scratches and possible relay changes.
- **VOLUNTEERS DO CHECK IN:** Volunteers are required to check-in at the volunteer check in tent see attached map for location.
- **SWIMTOPIA & MEET MOBILE APPS:** Live push notifications can be turned on and you will get updated event times straight to your phones. This will greatly assist all swimmers getting to their events on time. Be sure to download Swimtopia and take advantage of this perk it works on both the free and paid versions of the app.
- COACHES TO SWIMMER/PARENT INFO: Please read this <u>information sheet</u>, and for our 10 & Under swimmers, pay special attention to the "NAME ON THE ARM" instructions (keep scrolling down on the web page).
- CHAMPS AWARDS: Swimmers are awarded a Gold, Silver or Bronze medal if they achieve a
  personal best (PB) at CHAMPS. We encourage our Sea Otters to always strive for a new PB...
  but this time, there's hardware in it!
- **SEA OTTERS TENT:** Please drop by in the morning before the meet to collect your coaches gift, write your event/heat on your hand, write your name on your arm, and then come back in the afternoon for snacks and goodies. We can also answer general questions.
- ZOOM PHOTOGRAPHY: Pinehurst has partnered with Zoom Photography who will be offering
  professional action photography services at Champs! To include your athlete, registration is
  online only. Photos are only taken of athletes who register online with Zoom before the race.

# **PARADE OF TEAMS AT CHAMPS**

Before the meet begins, all teams will participate in the traditional Parade of Teams (think Olympic opening ceremony) to show off their spirit — wild wigs, team gear, mascots, and more! To help things run smoothly, here's what Sea Otter families need to know:

- Only swimmers and coaches are allowed on deck. Parents can watch from the stands.
- Medley Relay swimmers will go directly to the blocks after the parade they must wear their team suit and bring their cap and goggles with them.
- Swimmers will gather on the large concrete area near our tent camp. Look for Lauren Sullivan and listen for announcements.
- Team spirit is a must! Wear your Sea Otter spirit shirt, blue/gold gear, wigs, tutus, face paint, temporary tattoos go all out!
- We'll provide props and decorations please return them to the Sea Otters tent after the parade so we can reuse them next year.
- 8 & Under Butterfly swimmers should go straight to Clerk of Course after the National Anthem.
- First shift volunteers: Be ready to go immediately after the parade.
- Senior swim & recognition will be after the parade. We'll have more info on lane assignments and where parents should stand in the next few days.

Let's make a splash and show everyone that Sea Otters bring the spirit!
