We project that if we can keep our fundraising about the level it is now and with all our major expenses of new equipment out of the way, we should not have to raise fees again for some time baring any major shifts in expenses. If you look around our league and other teams in our area, you will find that our fees are still average to below average. To be a Benicia Stingrays, it is a mere \$3.50/day per swimmer, and we believe this is a very modest cost for such an outstanding and fun recreational swim team!

In closing I would like to say I am very proud of your Board they have worked diligently this off season to make the coming 2012 season the best it can be. Also my hat is off to Coach Kevin. He is always willing and available to answer the Boards calls and continues to work on making the Stingrays the best it can be.
