It has been said that it's harder for a champion to repeat than to win for the first time. So how hard is it to repeat a second time? The 2010 Stingrays must have been digging deep at this year's Tri-County conference meet because they more than sealed the deal with their third conference championship in as many years. Another summer of early mornings and hard work were well rewarded as the Stingrays came home with 2775 points and the 1st place trophy. Along the way, the Stingrays won six of the ten age groups having nearly missed several others by the narrowest of margins. The 8 and Under Boys, the 9-10 Girls, the 11-12 Girls, the 11-12 Boys, the 13-14 Girls, and the 15-18 Boys all captured age group trophies this year. Additionally, Cross Plains swimmers set seven new conference records highlighted by the exceptional weekend of Jackson Uselman. Not only did Jackson break the conference record in each of his three individual events in Saturday's prelims, but he went on to break all three of his records in Sunday's finals as well as lead the 13-14 boys to a record in the 200 Medley Relay.
