#### Stingrays Make It Four in a Row

At the annual Tri-Country conference championship swim meet in Baraboo, Cross Plains once again claimed the title of conference champion. With a score of 2709.5, the Stingrays brought the 1<sup>st</sup> place trophy to Cross Plains for the 4<sup>th</sup> year in a row. Along the way, they captured the high score in the following age groups: 8 and Under Girls, 9-10 Girls, 9-10 Boys, 11-12 Boys, 13-14 Girls, 15-18 Girls, and 15-18 Boys. They also reshaped the conference record book with several swimmers setting records that were established years before they were born. In all, Stingray swimmers set an impressive 10 conference records. The new Tri-Country conference records held by Stingrays are as follows:

While there were numerous Stingray individual and relay conference champions at this weekend's meet, one swimmer, Jackson Uselman was able to achieve this in all four events in which he was entered.

In a meet filled with exceptional swims, one of the most notable was the Boy's 15-18 Freestyle Relay team of Jackson Uselman, Mike Key, Brian Andryk, and Derek Uselman. While no swimmers from any other team had posted a 50 yard freestyle time under 23 seconds that day, the CP 15-18 relay was eying the record set 9 vears earlier by another Cross Plains relay team that would require all four swimmers together to average a split time under 23 seconds. With the meet well in hand and the nearest competitor nearly 5 seconds back, the team posted split times of 22.37, 22.85, 22.43, and 21.92 for a combined time of 1:29.57 burying the previous record of 1:31.65 by more than 2 seconds.
